Important notice - please read carefully!

Due to the tremendous growth of the Daf Hashovua program, the following changes are being implemented going forward:

- A) The weekly *bechina* on Gemara-Rashi will be in multiple-choice form and should therefore be easier to take and grade.
- B) The test deadline will be, at midnight MONDAY night (NY time).
- C) The weekly incentive for a score of 90 or above will be a \$5 certificate to any one of our preferred *seforim* store vendors.
- D) We will only grade and offer incentives for *bechinos* taken with a closed gemara. We encourage those who prefer to continue taking the test with an open *gemara*. The answer key will be published after the deadline.
- E) For the time being, we are only offering this version of the weekly *bechina*.
- F) Please only send in the one-page answer sheet which appears on the last page.
- G) When emailing the answer sheet as an attachment, label the document with your last name, first name, and daf number in that order.
- H) **NEW: You can now take the *bechina* digitally and receive your score immediately. Check the link in this week's newsletter. If you didn't receive the link, check our website dafaweek.org/bechinos.**

All questions are multiple choice or true/false.

- 1) The גמרא says that הנביא ר' would split the פסוקים when teaching the kids. The גמרא bought this down to...

 - B.  - The ת"ק is not worried about גזירת הנכנסין, because when people come late, they could ask somebody in Shul what happened to the three פסוקים.
 - The ת"ק is not worried about גזירת היוצאין, since it's not common for people to leave while the Sefer Torah is open.
 - B and C are correct.
- 6) Rav visited a מבבל and got an עליה. How did he proceed?
- He made a ברכה before and after.
 - He made a ברכה only before.

- 7) Which of the following statements are correct?
- Rav and Shmuel were both כהנים.
