I: Words

Individually, that is, without a minyan (5a, line 2) – בִּיחִיד (1)

With ten, i.e. a minyan (5a, line 3) – בְּעֶשְׂרֵה (2)

Festival offering (5a -in mishna) – חֲגִיגָה (3)

Special gathering once every 7 years at end of Sukkot (5a, in mishna) – הַקְהָל (4)

eulogy (5a, in mishna) – הַסִּפּוּד (5)

A fast day, can be public (like fasting for rain) or private (bad dream) (5a, in mishna) – תַּעֲנִית (6)

suffering (5a 5th wide line) – פּוֹרְעָנוֹת (7)

II: Gemara phrases

It once happened (5a, 4th line) – הָיָה עוֹבְדָא (1)

This is how it should be read (5a, 9th line) – הַכִּי קֶאֱמַר (2)

To exclude (5a, line 12) – לְאַפּוֹקִי (3)

He is in doubt about it (5b, 20th line) – מְסַפְקָא לִיהּ (4)

Who is it? (usu. according to whose opinion?) (5b, 8th line up from wide lines) – מִנִּי (5)

III: Arguments

If ____ falls on Shabbat, you do it when? and why?

Purim	go back to read on Thurs or Friday	The megilla says “ולא יעבור”, you cannot go later
Tisha Bav	Fast Sunday	We are never eager to start suffering
Chagiga	Offer the next day or any other festival day	Cannot offer it earlier, bc the time of obligation has not yet arrived
Hakhel	Do it Sunday	They had to construct special bleachers, which couldn't be done on Shabbat (Rashi, based on Yerushalmi)
