1. The Source for Lag BaOmer Celebrations

Chatam Sofer(Responsa Yoreh Deah 233)

15th of Nissan-Yetziat Mitzrayim 15th of Iyar-supplies depleted 3 days without food 18th Iyar-Manna began to descend

2. Omer and manna- 3 things to know

a) Vayikra Rabba 28:3

b) Shemot 16:4

Manna was "bread from Heaven

c) Manna ends with the first Karban Ha Omer Yehoshua 5: 11-12

וַיּאכְלוּ מֵעֲבָוּר הָאֶָרֶץ מִמּחֲרַת הַפֶּסַח מַצַּוֹת וְקָלֵוּי בְּעֻצֶם הַיָּוֹם הַזֶּה:

On the day after the passover offering, on that very day, they ate of the produce of the country, unleavened bread and parched grain.

On that same day,^dLit. "on the day after." when they ate of the produce of the land, the manna ceased. The Israelites got no more manna; that year they ate of the yield of the land of Canaan.

The omer offering gave permission to eat from the harvest

3. Omer per person

From here the Sages also said: One who eats roughly this amount each day, is healthy, as he is able to eat a proper meal; and he is also blessed, as he is not a glutton who requires more. One who eats more than this is a glutton, while one who eats less than this has damaged bowels and must see to his health.

4. Bread "from heaven" or bread of Angels

a) Yoma 75b

The Sages taught: The Torah states: "And He caused manna to rain upon them for food, and He gave them of the grain of heaven. Man did eat the bread of the mighty [*abirim*]" (Psalms 78:24–25). "**Bread of the mighty" is bread that the ministering angels eat;** this is the statement of Rabbi Akiva. When these words were said before Rabbi Yishmael, he said to them to go and tell Akiva: Akiva you have erred. Do the ministering angels eat bread? It is already stated about Moses, when he ascended on high: "Bread I did not eat and water I did not drink" (Deuteronomy 9:9). If even a man who ascends on high does not need to eat, certainly the ministering angels do not need to eat. Rather, how do I establish the meaning of the word *abirim*? It can be explained as bread that was absorbed into all 248 limbs [*eivarim*], so that there was no waste.

b) What is an Angel

Associating our eating/ absorbing Hashem's Ratzon comes with packaging that we use and then dismiss so that we only absorb the nutrients.

Ex. materiality is the envelope- not the ends itself OMer is the concept of sufficiency -Sufficiency= having our true needs met which makes us feel RICH

False needs get in the way of our "Superangel work"

6. Lag B'Omer - Kavod

a) Omer = Yakar Esther 8:16-

ַלִיְהוּדִּׁים הֶיְתָּה אוֹרָה וְשִׂמְחֵה וְשָׂשָׁן וִיקֶר: The Jews enjoyed light and gladness, happiness and honor.

Kavod and Yakar

Lack of kavod for the other comes from feeling insufficient Personal sense of "chisaron" dissatisfaction, being disadvantaged precludes our carving out that stream for the flow of greater Ohr, and our energies are wanted on competing for more of what we feel we are missing

Remembering the manna- what our built in needs are, because fulfilling those needs makes us feel rich Manufactured needs, which are cultivated by the seeing the packaging as the goal created an Ayin Ra on others
