


Permissible row of vegetables (e.g. carrots) in a field of vegetables (e.g. cabbages)


According to R' Akiva (according to ש"ג). The Halacha follows this opinion.



R' Akiva does not require the row be "מפולש"
(i.e. it can be surrounded on 3 sides).

Permissible row of vegetables (e.g. carrots) in a field of vegetables (e.g. cabbages)


According to R' Yishmael (according to ר' ישמעאל)



R' Yishmael requires the row be "מפולש"

(i.e. from end-to-end, so row is only surrounded on 2 sides, not 3.)
