I: Words

- Gehinnom (14a, 8th wide line) – גֵּיהֶנּוֹם (1)
Capitals laws (i.e. death penalty) (14a, last line) – דִּינֵי נַפְשׁוֹת (2)
Women are merciful (14b, 21st line) – נָשִׁים רַחֲמָנִיּוֹת הֵן (3)
The Ten {lost} tribes (14b,) – עֲשֶׂרֶת הַשְּׁבֵטִים (4)
And she married (14b, last line) – וְנִסְכָּה (5)

II: Gemara phrases

- To what may this matter be compared ? (14a, 1st line) – לְמַה הַדָּבָר דּוֹמֶה (1)
Still (14a, 1st wide line) – אַפְתִּי (2)
Questionable (14a, 1st wide line) – קִשְׁיָא (3)
Conclusion (14b, 9th line) – מְסֻקָּנָא (4)
From me (my teaching) and from you (your teaching), the – מִיְנִי וּמִיְנֶיךָ תְּסַתְיִים שְׂמֵעָתָא (5)
teaching may be completed (i.e. by combining them) (14b, 2nd to last line)

III: Arguments

Famous statements on this Daf:

- 1) Prophecy of Miriam that her mother would give birth to the one who would save srael from Egypt (which convinced her parents to re-marry.)
- 2) When Moshe was born, the house was filled with light
- 3) There is no artist like Hashem

The 48 Prophets (Rashi)

Avraham, Yitzchak, Yaakov, Moshe, Aaron, Yehoshua, Pinchas, Elkana, Eli, Shmuel, Gad, Natan, David, Sh'lomo, (Sh'maya), Ido, Michaya ben Yamla, Ovadia, Achia ha-Shiloni, Yehu ben Chanani, Azarya ben Oded, Chazael, Elazar, Hoshea, Amos, Micha, Amotz, Eliyahu, Elisha, Yonah, Yeshaya, Yoel, Nachum, Chabakuk, Zefanya, Uriah, Yirmiya, Yechezkel, (Daniel), Baruch, Nerya, Seraya, Machsaya, Chagai, Zecharya, Malachi, Mordechai (45)

The 46th is either Sh'maya or Daniel. (Rashi seems unsure) and he says he doesn't know who the last 2 are. The Gr'a puts in (47) Chanani and (48) Oded. Rabbeinu Chananel omits Avraham, Yitzchak and Ya'akov (as well as Chazael, Nerya, Seraya and Machsaya) and inserts Assir, Aviassaf and the sons of Korach, Assaf, Heiman, Yedutun, Yehu, and Eliezer ben Dodiya.
