

Shmuel 1 Perek 8

- Shmuel appointed his children Yoel and Aviyah to be Judges over Yisrael in his old Age.
- Yoel and Aviyah did not follow in Shmuel's ways. Yoel and Aviyah would take bribes for judging Yisrael (this was a sin on their level.)
- Yisrael approached Shmuel and requested to have a King rule them. They wanted to be like the nations of the world.
- Shmuel asked Hashem. Hashem related to Shmuel Yisrael's desire to be ruled like a king is a direct rejection of Hashem.
- Shmuel related to the entire nation the harshness that will accompany Yisrael with appointment of king.
- Yisrael still expressed desire to be ruled by a king.
- Hashem "consented" and told Shmuel to listen to Yisrael.
