- 11. Accepted only those minhagim based on Talmudic sources.
- 12. Kabbalistic ideas are frequently open to misunderstanding.
- 13. Opposed the rise of Chassidus and all changes to the Siddur.
- 14. Forbade all use of amulets.
- 15. Arbitrated dispute of R.Yaakov Emden and R.Yonassan Eibeshutz.
- 16. Condemned the Haskalah movement of Wessley and Mendelssohn.
- 17. Highly respected in Government circles, prevented anti-semitic measures.
