

Case: Planting rows (שורות) of gounds in a field (הארה) of onions


According to Chachamim. The Halacha follows the Chachamim.



The Chachamim require one: (1) 12 amos between rows of gounds is required but lenient on the other: (2) Only a furrow (תלם) between gounds and onions

Case: Planting rows (שורות) of gounds in a field (שדה) of onions

According to R' Akiva




R' Akiva requires neither:

- (1) 8 amos between rows of gounds is sufficient
- (2) Only a furrow (תלם) between gounds and onions

Case: Planting rows (שורות) of gounds in a field (שדה) of onions

According to R' Yishmael



R' Yishmael requires both: (1) 12 amos between rows of gourds
(2) 2 unplanted amos between gourds and onions
