Figure 1: Two rows of tables, running north to south. Each table is two cubits long and one cubit wide. The two rows each protrude slightly into the southern quarter because it is impossible to contain ten cubits within a space of exactly ten cubits. Moses' table is centered between the two rows. The terms right and left are for one facing Moses' table from the southern quarter. Moses's table is removed 2½ cubits from northern wall.

Figure 2: The rows of tables are from east to west. There is a two and one half cubit passageway between the tables and the wall. Moses' table is all the way in the west. The descriptions, left and right are for one entering the sanctuary.
