

Yechezkel Perek 10

Note: This is just a recording of the written pesukim. None of this is meant to be taken literally.

This is a continuation of Yechezkel's "top down" vision of the chariot.

Yechezkel saw Hashem's chariot. It looked like Cheruvim.

Hashem commanded the man wearing linen to grab fire from the wheels of the chariot. The fire was to be thrown on Yerushalayim.

A cloud of God's Glory filled the court yard of the Beis Hamikdash.

The sounds that emanated from the wings of the Cheruvim sounded like the voice of Hashem.

Yechezkel described what the chariot actually looked like.

Yechezkel then described how the heavenly chariot departed from the Beis Hamikdash.

Yechezkel related that this vision was the same as the one he had seen on the River of Kvar. (Perek 1)
