

Yechezkel Perek 36

Perek 36 is a prophecy regarding the ingathering of the exiles and the process of redemption.

Note: We are currently living through the beginning of many of these prophecies.

Eretz Yisrael was made the laughingstock of all the lands.

God will punish Edom for how much they made Eretz Yisrael suffer.

The mountains will flourish and fruit will grow in Eretz Yisrael. Note: this is one of the clear signs of the redemption, as when the nations of the world occupied Eretz Yisrael they, by and large, couldn't get anything to grow. Thank you, Hashem, for the fruit and vegetation that is growing today throughout Eretz Yisrael!

God will bring Am Yisrael back to Eretz Yisrael.

Am Yisrael will start to resettle the land.

Am Yisrael will start to rebuild the "ruins of old."

The nations will stop saying that the Jewish people have committed atrocities. (Sound familiar?)

"When My nation was exiled it caused a desecration of My name.

"The return of Am Yisrael to their soil will cause a sanctification of the name of God.

"I will sprinkle water on you and purify you from all your sins.

"I will give you a new heart and turn your heart of stone into a heart of flesh."

Am Yisrael will keep God's Torah.

Eretz Yisrael will be rebuilt, resettled and repopulated. (Note the mass amount of construction that is taking place in Eretz Yisrael now.)
