

Local teens off to New Orleans

Rabbi Ethan Katz, New Jersey NCSY associate regional director, will take Jewish teen leaders to New Orleans for two relief missions, from March 1 to 6 and from April 6 to 10. NCSY is the international youth movement of the Orthodox Union.

Students on the first mission, from Rae Kushner Yeshiva High School in Livingston, will volunteer with Common Grounds, a New Orleans-based nonprofit dedicated to repairing and strengthening communal life of the city. Teens on the second mission, from The Frisch School in Paramus, will work with Habitat for Humanity. During both missions students will assist in rebuilding homes in the city and visit the local Orthodox community and day school.
