CROCHET & DARNING CLASSES IN TERM 4 WITH ELIZABETH LACEBROOK

- 10 week course starting in October
- Afternoon and evening class options

The first six weeks of the term will cover:

INTRODUCTION TO CROCHET (suitable for beginners)

- ♦ Learn how to crochet using "normal size" hooks and yarn
- ♦ Learn how to read patterns
- ♦ Understanding tension and gauge
- ♦ Create a number of small projects (eg coaster, oven mitt, bag, scarf)

INTRODUCTION TO DARNING (suitable for beginners)

Do you have a jumper with moth holes? A garment with a small tear? Or other sad something that needs repair? Bring it along and work on it in class

- ♦ Learn how to darn knitted and woven fabric
- ♦ Invisible, visible and quick repair techniques

In the last four weeks of the term there will be flexibility. You can:

- continue to work on projects from patterns provided by Elizabeth
- work on a project of your choice (crochet or darning) with the support and guidance of Elizabeth
- choose to further develop your skills with Intermediate Crochet and/or Lace Crochet

INTERMEDIATE CROCHET (for intermediate & experienced)

At this level you will learn more advanced crochet techniques. You can choose the projects and styles that interest you or bring along your own project

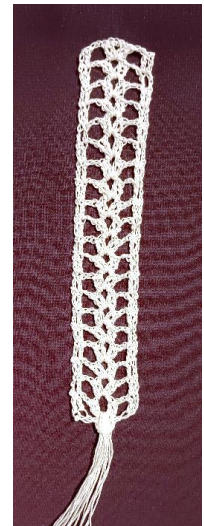
- ♦ Some suggestions: gloves/fingerless gloves, bookcover, bag, crochet toy, tea cosy
- ♦ How to choose the right pattern (and about AI patterns) and wool for projects
- ♦ Understanding more complex patterns and how to adapt them
- ♦ Crochet techniques such as colourwork crochet, surface crochet, crochet in the round
- ♦ Bring along a crochet problem!

LACE CROCHET (suitable for beginners - experienced)

- ♦ Learn how to do lace crochet (it's not as hard as it looks!)
- ♦ Using small hooks and fine cotton thread
- ♦ Learn how to read patterns (including vintage patterns)
- ♦ Techniques and styles of lace and attachment methods
- ♦ Crochet project options: bookmarks, lace trim, book corner, small doily, lace ribbon

YOU WILL BE ABLE TO PURCHASE KITS AND MATERIALS IN CLASS

- ♦ CROCHET MATERIALS: hooks, yarn, patterns and notions
- ♦ LACE KITS these include pattern, thread, hook and notions
- ♦ DARNING KITS these include darning mushroom, thread, darning needles, unpicker, beeswax and notions
