To ensure effective communication with; parents and participants.

To ensure the health and safety of all participants, ensuring participants follow safety rules.

To adhere to the policies of Land and Leaf Collective.

To enjoy motivating and inspiring children across different ranges of age, ability and confidence.

To offer time to discuss any additional needs or accessibility of volunteering

To provide an induction to the organisation, forest school principles and health and safety

To offer ongoing in house training and support relevant to the role

To provide regular progress meetings to volunteers
