

Cambridge Sword Kit management policy for electric kit

Created 3rd September to be reviewed Jan 26

The club has appointed a Kit Manager who will operate and monitor this policy and look after the kit. We need our coaches to do their bit to ensure the policy works and that we have as much working kit as possible and repairs are kept to minimum by taking due care of the kit.

The Kit Manager is Archie Broughton our Club Coach and Assistant Club Manager

The club owns many electric boxes, spools, lames, body wires etc – a full inventory will be published by end October

1. This kit must be handled carefully – it is valuable, and replacement would be very difficult
2. Fencers must be taught how to handle it. Turning boxes on and off with feet or foils is UNACCEPTABLE and the fencer will receive a yellow and escalating warnings if they persist.
3. Broken kit MUST be isolated during the session and a label attached saying what is wrong with it. This includes fencers' own kit – even more important that it is labelled.
4. At the end of a session the broken kit should be put on the broken kit shelf
5. The Kit Manager will turn around the repair as soon as possible
