Drop-off

Our Hive 11+ Tutoring sessions begin at **5pm**. Unfortunately, due to site restrictions, it is not possible to drop your child off earlier than 5pm.

We will be based in the main school building, so please head towards the main school reception, where you will see a Hive banner and registration desk.

Students will be welcomed each afternoon by members of our friendly team and will have an array of engaging 'Warm Up' activities set up in classrooms to complete.

Pick Up

Unless permission has been given for independent travel, a named guardian will need to collect students at the end of the session. **Pick up is at 7pm each Tuesday evening.**

Schedule

Each session will follow a three-part '**Model** - **Practice** - **Review**' structure. In the model section, the teacher will introduce a new technique or question style, and will **model** how it can be solved. Students will then have an independent opportunity to **practice** questions, before a teacher-led **review** of these practice questions.

Two components (from Verbal, Non-Verbal, English, Maths) will be completed per day with a short break between them.

What to bring

Students must bring the following items each day:

- A water bottle (this can be filled up throughout the afternoon/evening on site)
- A snack for the short break between sessions.
- Any required medication - details of which should be entered on the enrolment form or via email to rob@hiveeducationgroup.com.

Students should attend in casual clothing with suitable footwear.

What not to bring

We will provide all necessary equipment for learning sessions, so no pens or pencils need to be brought in, unless your child wishes to bring their own equipment.
