Where an employer's assessment of First Aid needs identifies that a first aider is not necessary, the minimum requirement for an employer is to appoint a person to take charge of the first aid arrangements.

This includes looking after the equipment and facilities and calling the emergency services when required. Arrangements should be made for an 'Appointed Person' to be available to undertake these duties at all times when people are at work.
