



HEALTH AND SAFETY

Policy Statement

It is the policy of Land and Leaf Collective to comply with the terms of the Health & Safety at Work Act 1974 and subsequent legislation, to provide and maintain safe and healthy working conditions, equipment and systems of work for all our employees and to provide such information, training and supervision as they need for this purpose.

Land and Leaf Collective also recognises and accepts its responsibility to protect Health and Safety of all visitors to the workplace (including contractors, temporary staff and any members of the public) who might be affected by its activities. The company carries out risk assessments of resources, activities and sites.

Land and Leaf Collective also recognises and accepts its responsibility to protect the health & safety of all its employees, volunteers, contractors, service users and visitors when undertaking activities outside the registered premises. The company will comply with the terms of the Health & Safety policy and procedures of the third party and carry out risk assessments as appropriate.

Land and Leaf Collective will ensure risk assessments are carried out as appropriate to ensure the needs of customers with disabilities and or learning difficulties are met and monitored.

This includes making reasonable adjustments in accordance with the Equality Act 2010 to prevent disadvantage to individuals with protected characteristics.

More detailed information and procedures can be found in the WOODLAND SAFETY policy which is shared with all participants and contracting third parties.

A copy of this policy will be issued to all members of staff and the policy will be kept up to date and the way in which it is operated will be reviewed each year. The responsibility for specific arrangements and implementation of the policy lies with the Directors.
