The following reminder regarding finances:

Payment due date: All accounts must be settled in advance by the 7th of each month.

**Late Payment Penalties:** Failure to pay by the due date will incur interest charges at a rate of 1.6 times the prime interest rate.

**Arrears and Attendance:** Accounts that remain in arrears for 60 days will result in the learner(s) barred from attending school. Additionally the account will be referred to our attorneys for collection. Members of learners with accounts in arrears will forfeit all rights to participate in decision-making processes within the school.

Reports: No academic reports will be provided to accounts that are in arrears for 60 days or more.
