

Tools Required:
Trim release tool, 10mm Socket, Ratchet & Side cutters, Flat bladed screwdriver.





Towbar Wiring Harness Fitting Instructions




- 1. Open the rear RHS access cover in the Ute tub liner.
- 2. Connect the trailer harness (1) into the control box (2).
- 3. Push the tab to allow the vehicle body harness tail lamp connector locking leaver (3) to rotate and separate the two halves of the connector.
- 4. Connect the trailer harness connector (4) between the two halves of the tail lamp connectors and refit the connector to the vehicle sheet metal.
- 5. Clean the outer face of the tub inner sheet metal.
- 6. Remove the backing paper from the adhesive pad (5) and apply it to the vehicle sheet metal, push firmly for 10 seconds to ensure permanent adhesion.

Note: If the vehicle wiring is different to the above wiring image please refer to Appendix A.






Towbar Wiring Harness Fitting Instructions



- Feed the end of the harness (1) up over the top of the RHS towbar end plate (2) and cable tie to the vehicle body harness (3).
- 2. Follow the body harness around the corner of the panel and up through in the vehicle tub (4).

Note: If the vehicle is fitted with Reverse Aid parking system (RPS) connect the round connector (5) to the RPS harness connector.




- 3. Remove the vehicle earthing bolt and add the trailer harness earth to the earthing point.
- 4. Cable tie the harness to vehicle body harness (3).
- 5. Refit all parts removed in reverse order.
- 6. Place the fitting instructions in the glove box of the vehicle.

APPENDIX A:



- 1. Open the rear RHS access cover in the Ute tub liner.
- 2. Connect the trailer harness (1) into the control box (2).
- 3. Push the tab to allow the vehicle trailer harness breakout connector locking leaver (3) to rotate and separate the two halves of the connector.
- 4. Connect the trailer harness connector (4) to the breakout connector (5) and fit the breakout connector cover to the spare connector of the trailer harness.
- 5. Clean the outer face of the tub inner sheet metal.
- 6. Remove the backing paper from the adhesive pad (6) and apply it to the vehicle sheet metal, push firmly for 10 seconds to ensure permanent adhesion.
