

- Check behind chassis rail and body panels before drilling to ensure no hazards are present

General:

- Before fitting this towbar read fitting instructions and check installation hardware is correct.
- Check that the towbar is suitable for the vehicle and be wary of any changes to the vehicle design that may conflict with the fitting of this towbar.
- After drilling, blow any filings clear, remove any swarf and treat exposed metal with a rust inhibitor.
- If this vehicle requires a bumper cut out, please check to make sure that you measure twice and check twice before cutting any panels as some bumper profiles can change. If you are not sure, then please ask your towbar supplier

a. Remove screws fastening the bumper to the body.	Phillips screwdriver, Torx wrench, 10mm spanner.			
b. Remove 6x Torx head screw fastening mudflap.				
c. Remove 2x bolts rearward of the mudflap.				
d. Repeat on LHS. Retain all fasteners.				
e. Remove 2 screws from the bottom of the bumper either side of spare wheel.				
f. Remove 2x screws from rear most lower				
bumper retainers & 4 screws attaching lower splash guards.				
g. Beginning at each wheel arch, gently peel the				
bumper away from the body around to the				
base of the taillight cavity.				
h. Disconnect the reverse sensor harness from				
the bumper.				
i. Retain the foam infills located on the crash				
bar.
