Towbar Fitting Instructions



Step-By-Step Instructions

Warning:

Safety First: Always use correct safety equipment.

This towbar is NOT to be drilled, cut, welded or modified in any way.

Check the surrounding area before drilling into chassis or body panels for fuel lines, wiring harnesses and other components that may be a hazard.

General:

Before fitting this towbar read fitting instructions and check installation hardware is correct.

Check that the towbar is suitable for the vehicle and be wary of any changes to the vehicle design that may conflict with the fitting of this towbar.

After drilling, blow any filings clear, remove any swarf and treat exposed metal with a rust inhibitor.

If this vehicle requires a bumper cut out, please check to make sure that you measure twice and check twice before cutting any panels as some bumper profiles can change.

If you are not sure then ask your towbar supplier.

Tighten all bolts as specified on the last page.

- 1. Remove rear beaver trim from inside boot x4 clips.
- 2. Release both quarter panel trims x2 clips.
- 3. Remove tail lights:
 - 3.1. X3 10mm nuts.
 - 3.2. 2 electrical plugs for each light.
 - 3.3. Lights pull out towards the rear of the car.
- 4. Lift out boot floor and remove the spare tyre.
- 5. Remove the rear bumper:
 - 5.1. Remove clip from inside of both wheel arches.
 - 5.2. Hold guard liner out to access 8mm bolt for bar corners.
 - 5.3. Remove x2 8mm bolts and x2 10mm bolts from the underside of the vehicle.
 - 5.4. Unclip number plate light electrical plug from impact beam and undo fitting.

- 5.5. Unclip bumper and store safely.
- 6. Remove impact beam 8x 14mm nuts.
- 7. Fit towbar over the impact beam bolts as well as the impact beam and tighten.
- 8. Using the extra hole in the towbar brackets as a guide, drill through the beaver panel on either side as well as the two holes required in the spare wheel well from underneath.
- 9. Coat all the drilled holes with an anti-corrosive and insert and tighten all the remaining bolts. (Including the nut, bolt and plate over the tow hook).
- 10. Carefully refit bumper and tail lights in opposite order to dismantling.
- 11. Fit tongue with bolts supplied.
- 12. Fit door sticker supplied to door.
