### **Step-By-Step Instructions**

#### Warning:

Safety First: Always use correct safety equipment.

This towbar is NOT to be drilled, cut, welded or modified in any way.

Check the surrounding area before drilling into chassis or body panels for fuel lines, wiring harnesses and other components that may be a hazard.

#### General:

Before fitting this towbar read fitting instructions and check installation hardware is correct.

Check that the towbar is suitable for the vehicle and be wary of any changes to the vehicle design that may conflict with the fitting of this towbar.


After drilling, blow any filings clear, remove any swarf and treat exposed metal with a rust inhibitor.

If this vehicle requires a bumper cut out, please check to make sure that you measure twice and check twice before cutting any panels as some bumper profiles can change.

If you are not sure then ask your towbar supplier.

Tighten all bolts as specified on the last page.

### Step 1. Remove Spare Wheel & Bumper

- Remove screws and scrivets from each wheel arch (1 x 10mm head bolt from top inside of each wheel arch).
- b. Remove spare wheel
- c. Drill out pop rivets from bottom of wheel well holding bumper support brace
- d. Remove 2 x small rubber grommets from wheel well [discard].
- e. Remove 2 large grommets [retain] each side to expose 14mm head bumper bolts to be removed carefully [Parts easily dropped into sub frame cavity] [retain bolts].
- f. Slide bumper rearwards [with help] disconnect number plate light and remove bumper completely placing on stand. [remove centre pop out]

### Step 2. Fit Towbar

- a. From inside of boot place 4 x bolts on wire through factory fittings corresponding with those on towbar across rear section of vehicle.
- b. Fit towbar using washers and nuts provided then proceed to bolt remaining bolts on wire through bottom holes in subframe.
- c. Fit 2 x cup head bolts and plates through bottom of wheel well and fasten with nuts and washers provided.
- d. Tighten all bolts to specified ratings (Pg.2).
- e. With holes in centre horizontal plate as a guide drill 2 x 11mm holes through bottom section of subframe cavity.
- f. Place long tapped plate into cavity and bolt using 2 remaining 3/8 bolts and washers.
- g. Reinstall bumper /pop rivet bumper support before reinstalling spare wheel.



## Step 3. Fit Ball Mount and Apply Door Sticker

- a. Attach plastic hitch surround to receiver.
- b. Insert ball mount into hitch receiver and secure with the pull pin and R-clip.
- c. Apply one of the compliance labels to the pillar of the driver's
- **d.** Leave the remaining label & the fitting instructions in the vehicle handbook.
