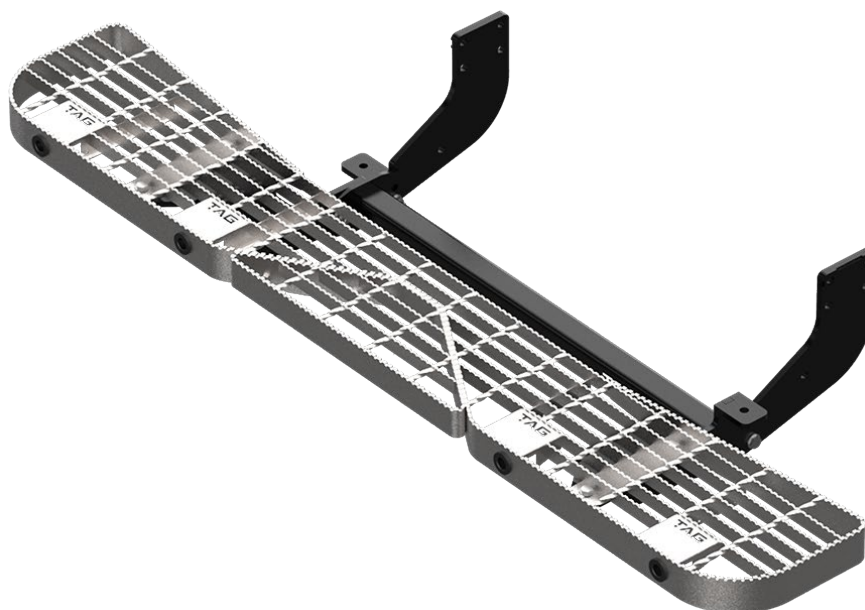

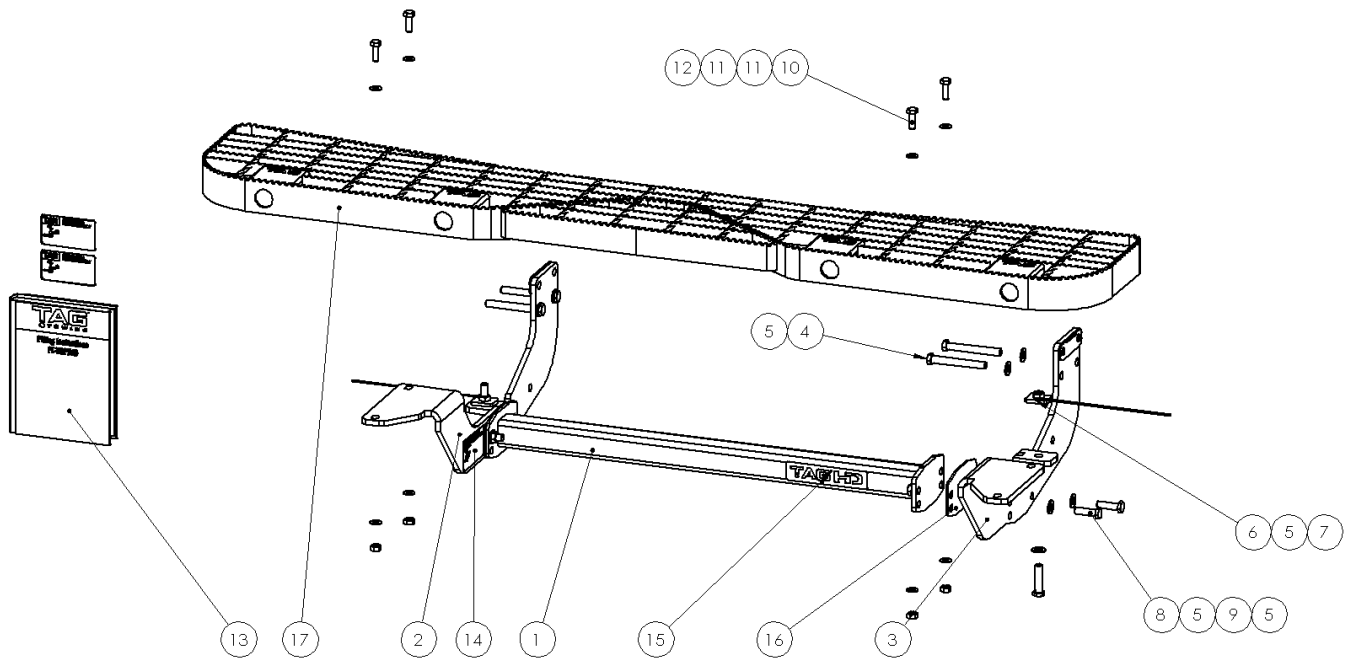

Important Information



Warning:

- This product is for towing purposes only and must only be loaded as shown in your vehicle Owner's Manual.
- This towbar is NOT to be drilled, cut, welded, or modified in any way.
- Check behind chassis rail and body panels before drilling to ensure no hazards are present.
- All load ratings shown are under the assumption your trailer has a functional braking system installed.
- When installed in positions other than the one depicted in these instructions the Tow Ball Mount may interfere or obstruct certain features of your vehicle (tailgate opening, Chassis clearance, etc.)

General:

- Before fitting this towbar read fitting instructions and check installation hardware is correct.
- Check that the towbar is suitable for the vehicle and be wary of any changes to the vehicle design that may conflict with the fitting of this towbar. (Tray, Canopy, Suspension etc.)
- After drilling, blow any filings clear, remove any burrs and treat exposed metal with a rust inhibitor.
- The high tensile fasteners supplied with this product are an integral feature to achieving the specified rating, if replacement is required ensure that fasteners of the same grade (8.8) & quality are used. Contact an authorised TAG distributor or the TAG fitment center - (07) 3208 3022 - if further information is required.

Towbar Maintenance and Care:

It is recommended, when not in use, the Tow Ball Mount assembly and class 4 Pin and Clip is stored inside the car away from moisture to prevent standing water from forming rust. Inspect to ensure, on regular basis, fasteners are torqued to the specifications below and in good condition.

Ensure that the fitting instructions are read and understood prior to fitment, Following the fitment place these instructions in the vehicle's glovebox after installation is completed.

Step 1: Fit Bar & Step

Note to installer: Fitting of this step will inhibit the correct function of the reverse sensors. It is recommended that the provided RSM Kit be used to relocate the OEM reverse sensors onto the step & wiring extended.

- a. Remove 2x M12 bolts from each chassis & discard.
- b. Lift PS endplate to the chassis & insert 2x M12x 100 bolts & flat washers into lower holes where original bolts were removed. Insert 2x M12x 100 bolts with washers into top holes & add flat washers & nuts to the outside. Leave loose.
- c. Insert nut plate on wire into lower chassis rail and loosely fasten with M12x 50 bolts & washers.
- d. Repeat on DS.
- e. Lift welded main bar up to end plates and insert 4x M12x 40 bolts with washers & nuts. Leave loose.
- f. If there is more than approx. 3mm clearance between the parts on each side, then spacers will be required.
- g. If the clearance is less than this, spacers will not be required between the parts.
- h. Mount the step onto the bracket /step assemblies and insert 4x M10x 30 bolts with flat washers & nuts. Leave loose.
- i. Fasten the M12 chassis bolts followed by the cross-member bolts to the torque specification on page 3.
- j. Align the step with the bumper and fasten the M10 step bolts.



Step 2: Complete Towbar & Apply Spare Compliance Label

- a. Apply one of the compliance labels to the pillar of the driver's door. Leave the remaining label and the fitting instructions in the vehicle handbook.
