- Coordinated the movement of a 129-man SEAL unit across two continents to carry out president directed offensive operations in Yemen
- Accomplished the insertion of 300 SOF personnel into Iraq in response to the encroachment of ISIS on Baghdad, creating the first US military presence in the country in over three years. Led a strike cell responsible for the removal of over 1,000 ISIS fighters from the battle field.
- Managed a budget of \$1.2 million for the planning and execution of a pre-deployment exercise that spanned seven states and 32 organizations, certifying a 275-man SEAL Team for combat operations
