


About Me

- I am an actor, director, choreographer, performer and researcher who was born in Tehran and currently lives in Istanbul. My early years were happy and lively... and all through my school years I really had no clear vision of any future, when time came for university, I chose mechanical engineering, I studied hard, as I always had done and got in. not knowing what the future had in store for me.
- The beginning of university meant that I had found a new kind of social life, and through that, I found Theatre, and as is said, the rest is history.... I fell in love with the Idea of a life as a performer, I quit Mechanical engineering which in of itself had its challenges and passes yet another university entrance exam to study theatre, in directing and acting. I got in the most prestigious university of my country the Tehran University of Art. My love of Acting and Performance meant that I began working immediately. My first performance was "Berlin Wall" by Shayan Afkari in Fajr international festival.
- Then I continued my way through the classes of Ali Akbar Alizad, Director of 84theater company and began my next work "Mountain language", directed by him, which was really precious for me in shaping my prospects of acting.
- through my studies I have found that I am ever more drawn to concepts of presence and absence as is suggested by Jacques Derrida in his treaties of Metaphysics of presence: "The enterprise of returning 'strategically', 'ideally', to an origin or to a priority thought to be simple, intact, normal, pure, standard, self-identical, in order then to think in terms of derivation, complication, deterioration, accident, etc."
- this returning to origins and the purity of movement has for me become the ideal to which I

strive to achieve, the authenticity that comes of this happens to create a straight line between invoking and conveying both complex and simple emotions in a way that can resonate with all who come to contact with it.

- to go back to the beginning for an instance, I had been told that in playing Pinter, what is unsaid is as
 important as what is said.... this instance as well as my involvement in the dance and performance
 scene in Iran brought me to realization that the presentation of an Idea or emotion can be done
 efficiently, effectively and more honestly through movements and physicality.
- my experience through modeling also made me more aware of the power of a fixed moment in time and it convey emotions in middle of a movement.
- now being in the digital age my question is how can we marry the authenticity of movement and the presentational aspects of the digital age.



Philosophical theoretical research in art history

Contemporary art is the art of today, produced in the second half of the 20th century or in the 21st century. Contemporary artists work in a globally influenced, culturally diverse, and technologically advancing world. Their art is a dynamic combination of materials, methods, concepts, and subjects that continue the challenging of boundaries that was already well underway in the 20th century. Diverse and eclectic, contemporary art as a whole is distinguished by the very lack of a uniform, organizing principle, ideology, or "-ism". Contemporary art is part of a cultural dialogue that concerns larger contextual frameworks such as personal and cultural identity, family, community, and nationality.

Philosophical theoretical background in acting and performing

Psychophysical Acting: An Intercultural Approach after Stanislavski

Psycho-physical Awareness is a popular acting technique used in Europe and USA. This technique works on the relationship between the mind and the body and at developing an actor's conscious awareness. In other words, recognizing the resulting sensory and mental states in reaction to physical stimuli. The pioneer of this technique is Konstantin Stanislavski who sought to overcome the divisions between "mind from body, knowledge from feeling, analysis from action" through psychophysical training or the method of physical action, but it was Michael Chekhov who further developed an original and dependable method of what we now know to be psycho-physical awareness.
