Acting:

September 2023 to January 2024 – Gulliver’s travels, Rose young company, Kingston: young company of the rose theatre. Phoebe played Gulliver in this production that was put on stage on the 28th of January.

August 2023 – Much ado about nothing, Rose theatre summer school ‘a play in a week’, Kingston: Phoebe undertook a play in a week production of Shakespeare’s Much ado about nothing, Phoebe played the character of Leonato, father of hero.

December 2022 – untitled production, Hampton Court House school: phoebe presented and performed in this production, phoebe performed a 3-minute monologue from the play ‘a hundred words for snow’ by tatty Hennessy. As well as this she introduced the other performances of the evening.

August 2022 – The odyssey, Rose theatre summer school ‘a play in a week’, Kingston: Phoebe was in a play in a week production of the odyssey, phoebe played the characters of: Eurycleia, Queen Arete, Athena, and ensemble.

December 2021 – untitled production, Hampton Court House school: Phoebe performed an extract from ‘waiting for Godot’, with one of her peers, under the direction of the drama department. Phoebe played the character of Vladimir.

Ballet:

September 2011 to present – Dance Direction ballet school under the direction of Meryl Moreth, former soloist at the Portuguese national ballet and graduate of the royal ballet school. Phoebe has received two ballet lessons a week, of over one hour length, as well as one pointe lesson. Phoebe is working toward the BBO intermediate exam and has achieved BBO grades 4 (merit), 3 (merit), 1 (merit), and primary (merit), as well as a merit in her intermediate foundation exam.

May 2023 – sleeping beauty ballet production, Esher Theatre: For five performances, pHoebe was selected to perform the role of aurora’ friend for half of the performances and assumed a role in the garland dance in act 1 and little red riding hood in act 3.

December 2022 – Dance showcase, Leatherhead Theatre: for three performances, Phoebe was a performer in the fiancés dance from swan lake, and little red riding hood in the dance from sleeping beauty.

December 2021 – Nutcracker, Esher theatre: for five performances in succession, Phoebe performed in the Merlitons’ dance.
