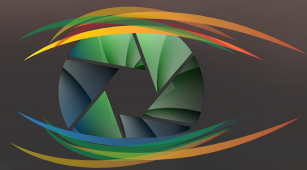

MAKING IT BIG IN THE MALE-DOMINATED AVIATION MAINTENANCE WORLD

Aircraft technicians repair and perform scheduled maintenance on aircraft. They diagnose and repair mechanical or electrical problems and replace damaged parts. Another important aspect is testing aircraft parts with gauges and other diagnostic equipment against manufacturer performance standards, while keeping records of maintenance and repair work. **Meet Gabriela Kamaahene, an airborne and aircraft maintenance technician. This is her story.**

CHILDHOOD DREAM

From an early age, Gabriela Kamaahene was fascinated by aircraft. She spent her childhood days at the airport, watching planes take off and land. Her dream was to become an aircraft technician. She was inspired by the stories of pilots and mechanics she heard from her father, who worked at the airport.

"My colleagues appreciate me as someone who assigns a high premium to quality workmanship. They know I don't take shortcuts. I do everything by the book."

Growing up in a family environment where gender was a less significant factor, Gabriela was encouraged to pursue her dream. She excelled in her studies, particularly in mathematics and science. She was a member of the National Student Council and the National Student Union.

BEST FRIENDS
Gabriela is a close friend with her mother, Amanda. They share a strong bond and often spend time together. Gabriela's mother is a source of support and encouragement.

RESPONSIBLE WORK
Throughout her career, Gabriela has been known for her attention to detail and commitment to safety. She always follows the manufacturer's instructions and uses the correct tools and equipment.

NEW DIRECTION

After completing Grade 12, Gabriela applied and was shortlisted for a pilot training program at the Kenya Civil Aviation Authority. However, the company's psychometric and aptitude tests that formed part of the application process revealed that she was not mechanically inclined, and as such, better suited for a career in the aviation industry.

"These were unexpected aspects of my personality that I didn't know about. Sometimes, I didn't feel equipped for a job that wasn't my first choice, but I decided to give it a try. I found that I enjoyed it and I wanted to explore it further."

Her parents and family were supportive of her decision. They encouraged her to pursue her passion and to focus on her studies. Gabriela was determined to make the most of her opportunity.

FIRST JOB
Upon successfully completing the 12-month program, Gabriela was assigned to her first job at the airport. She was responsible for performing routine maintenance on aircraft and ensuring that they were safe for flight.

"University is not for everyone, and often we overlook rewarding technical options, simple because we think of them as dirty work only men can do."

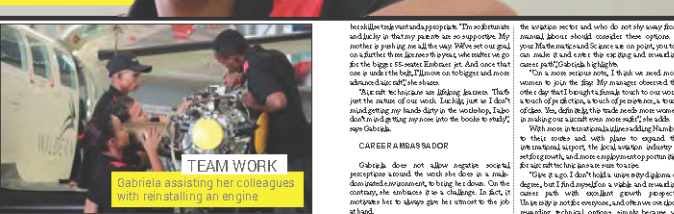
"It's not about the money, it's about the satisfaction of doing a job well. You can't put a price tag on that. It's about the pride in your work and the knowledge that you are contributing to the industry."

"Particularly, you should take into account that the aviation industry is a male-dominated one. It's not always easy to be a woman in this field, but I've found that my colleagues and supervisors are supportive and I've been able to overcome the challenges."

Aircraft are highly complex machines that require reliable parts and specialized skills to fly safely. To keep an airplane in peak operating condition, aircraft technicians examine aircraft lines and parts for defects, diagnose mechanical or electrical problems, and inspect parts for wear, using precision instruments. Reading an airframe is essential to identify a source of repair, they repair wings, fuselage, and other parts, and they inspect aircraft components for safety, using hand tools. Another important aspect is to test aircraft parts with gauges and other diagnostic equipment against manufacturer performance standards, while keeping records of maintenance and repair work.

Skills & Knowledge
High school courses in Mathematics and Science are considered useful, whereas computer software applications also stands out as a good fit. Aircraft technicians need to be physically fit and strong, with the ability to lift heavy parts. Aircraft technicians also need to be detail-oriented and have a strong sense of responsibility. A high level of attention to detail and the ability to work under pressure. Aircraft technicians also need safety consciousness as it is critical in ensuring that an aircraft is kept in top operating condition.

Training
Training is offered at registered training institutions. Most aircraft technicians have some sort of aviation and aviation-related experience. It is not necessary to have a degree, but a diploma or certificate in aviation is preferred. In many countries, a diploma or certificate in aviation is required for entry into the profession. Further training, many technicians opt for bachelor's degree programs in disciplines related to aviation technology and management.

Working Conditions
Aircraft technicians work in hangars, in a noisy, hot, and sometimes dusty environment. They may need to work long hours and may be required to work in various locations. The work can be both fun and challenging. Aircraft technicians often work in a team and may be required to work in a shift system. They also work in a male-dominated environment.

Job Prospects
Employment of aircraft technicians is concentrated in a small number of countries. The majority of aircraft technicians work for national airlines and private airlines companies. With their technical skills, many technicians are able to work in other industries and with private companies to expand the international airport, local aviation industry and other sectors. Most technicians also work in a male-dominated environment. There are many opportunities for advancement in the industry. Aircraft technicians can also work in a male-dominated environment.

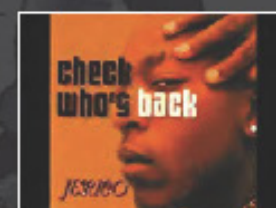

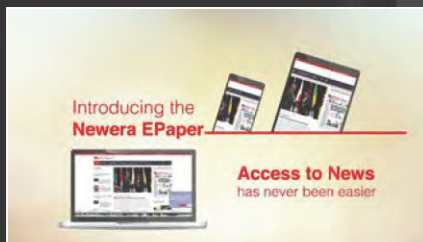
