I have several roles at Don Miller Septic. My primary role is septic pumper which has the following responsibilities:

- Pump out septic tanks as per scheduled and emergency appointments.
- Advise customer on any practice they should or should not be doing for their system.
- Look out for any signs of septic failure and inform customer of any concerning issues.
- Haul loads of septage to sewage authorities to properly dispose of wastewater or grease.
- Keep the work area running as efficiently as possible while working with other pumpers and administrative staff. This means I try to keep our holding tanks low as much as possible in case of after hours emergencies when running to a sewage authority would be cumbersome.

My secondary role is to help install septic systems, which means:

- Assist the main foreman in the task(s) of installing pipe, distribution box and filter fabric for a septic field.
- Assist in installing septic tanks and hooking up main waste water lines to them.
- Installing pumps in dosing tanks for systems that require them.
- Retrieving materials that are needed for installations.
- Running a dump truck to get filling material and to also get rid of materials.
- Minor maintenance to operating machines, for example greasing any and all joints for excavating machines.

My tertiary role is mainly that of Reliable worker. This business is a family business and I've been taught to give whatever I am doing my all. This just means that I try my best to make sure everyone I'm around or working with is set up to do their tasks as efficiently as possible. This usually boils down to communicating with multiple people and advising them on how to approach the work day and some job sites, keeping the peace whenever necessary, and keeping up morale.
