And that's not all – Ezekiel names Daniel, along with Noah and Job, as standards of righteousness as well. Wisdom and righteousness... not a bad combination for an Old Testament hero – and a worthy pair of character traits for any modern-day saint as well.

This first volume with 6 lessons of The Hand Writing on the Wall will take you in depth into the first six chapters of the book of Daniel.
