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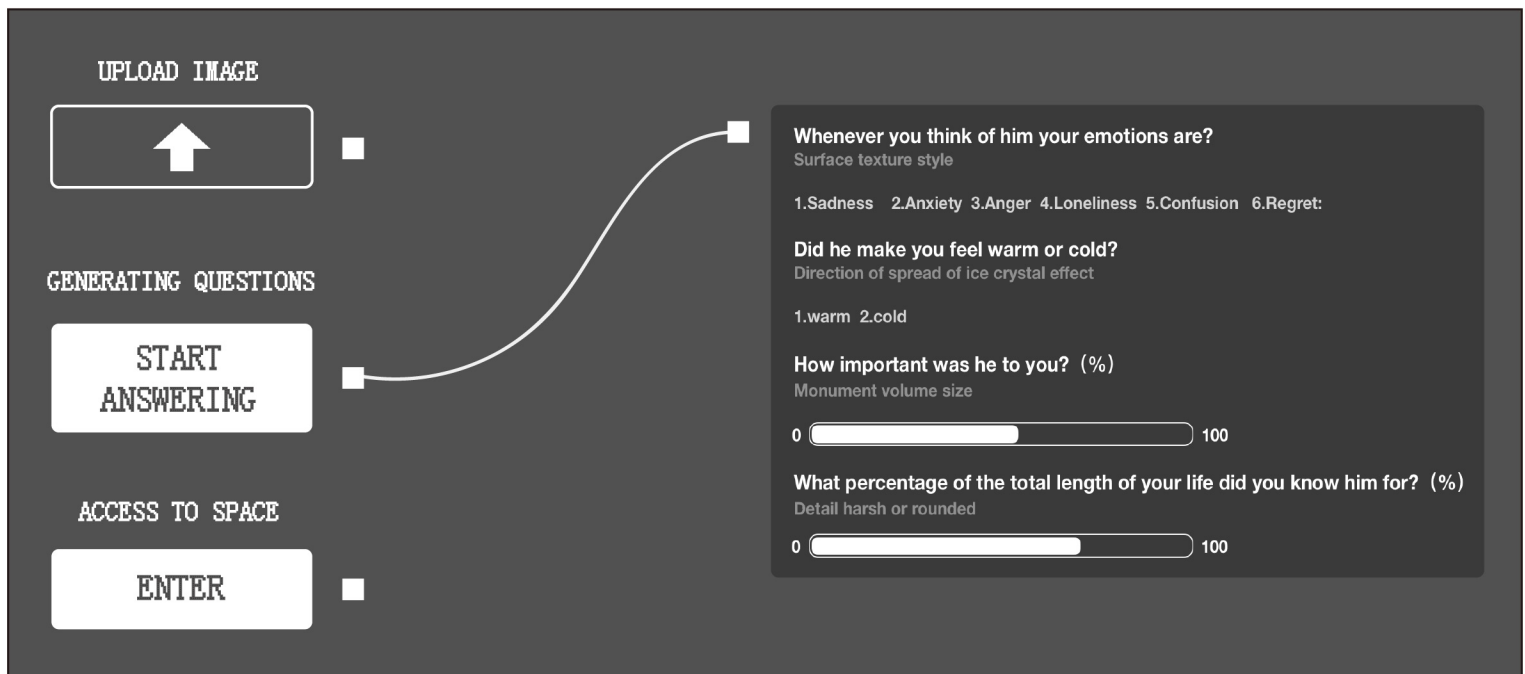

But behind this decision we are also destined to be unable to take with us all the memories of the past, especially those of our loved ones who have left us.

So when we face this change, it is clear that traditional tombstones and memorials are no longer a good way of remembering...

**BACKGROUND**



1. Firstly, people upload an image of the person they want to remember in the system,

2. After which the system will give a form which will ask you about your emotional state with the person you want to remember, and when you complete the form you will be given a customised memorial.

Remembrance and healing is a private act, so the memorial generated through the program had to be something that everyone could feel strongly about.

On the basis of the system-generated facial model, I set up different questions to correspond to changing the generative details of the head model, the

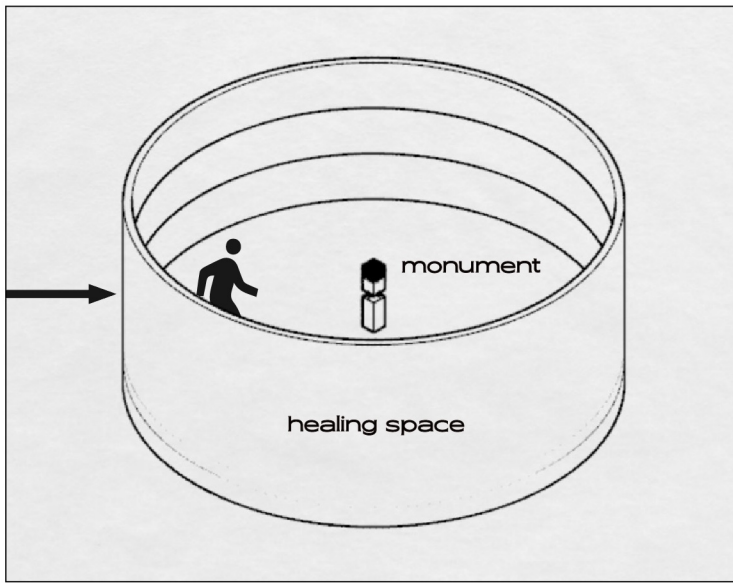
In contrast to the final form of the monument, the process of answering the monument generation questions is in itself a process of revisiting the memories and the relationship.

When you answer questions such as: Was this person warm or cold to you? What percentage of your life did you spend knowing this person? Questions such as these will allow the user to slowly sort out more subtle feelings and sensations from simple memories. And this is actually the first part of healing, because only when you really reflect on the memory will you have a better idea of how to get out of this grief and what is holding you back from your new life.

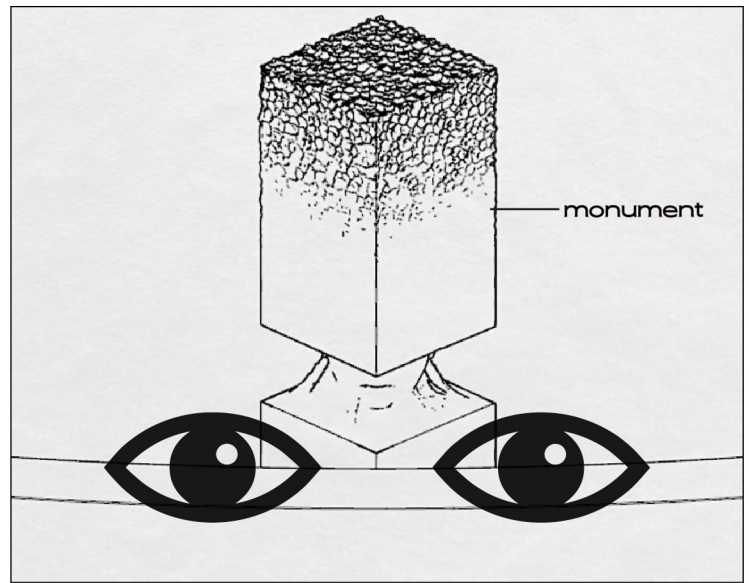

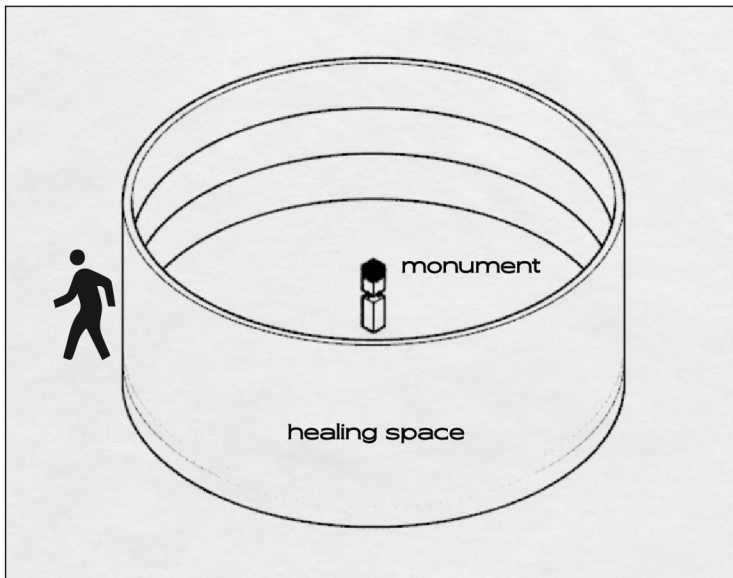




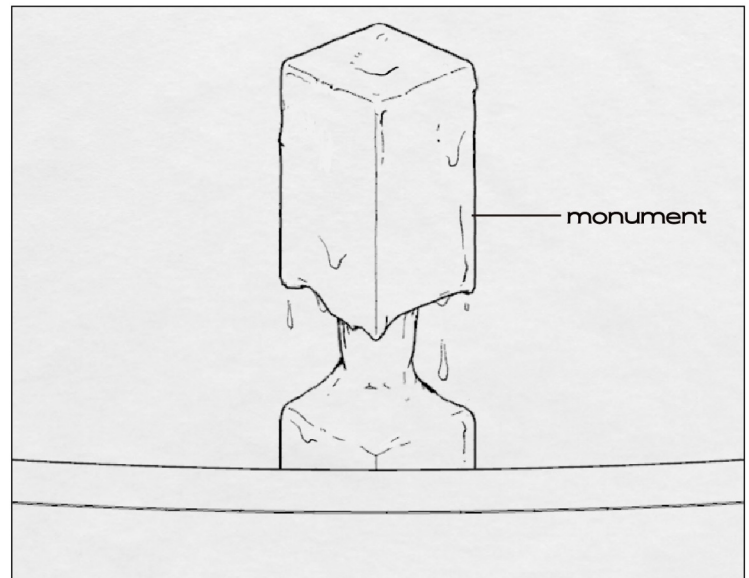
enter space

leave space

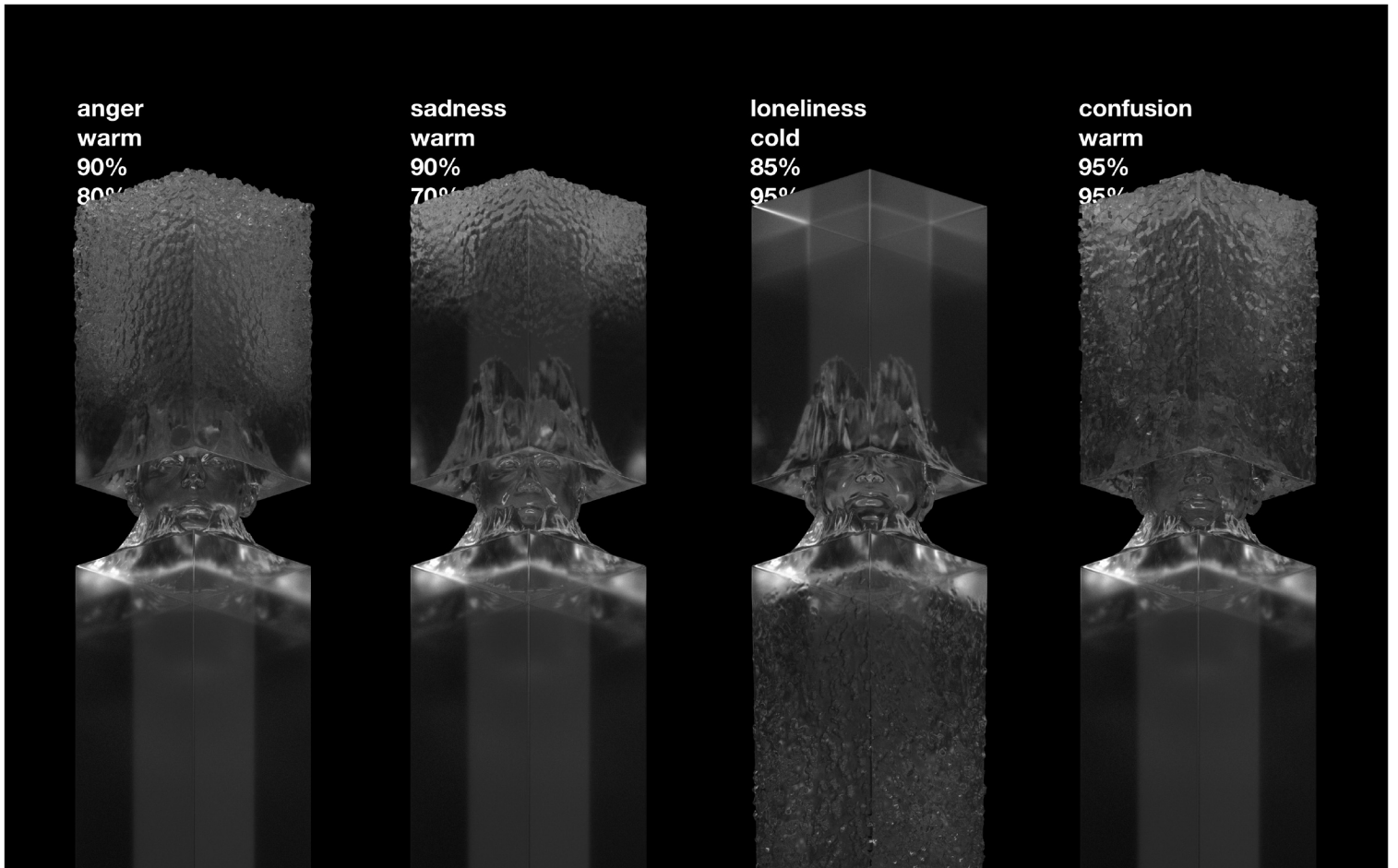
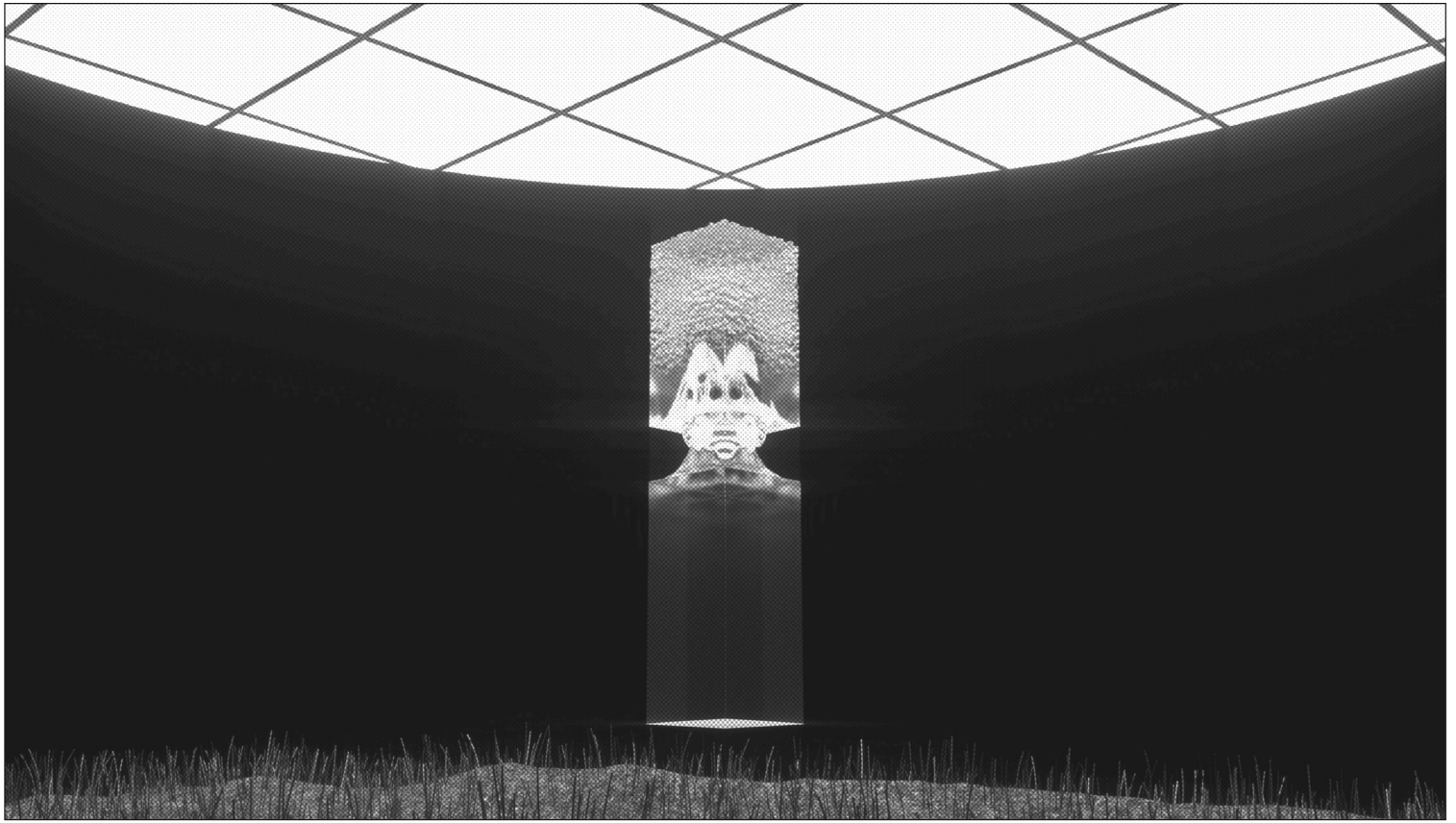


Monument completely melted after 180 days



In the time when no one visit, the monument will naturally dissolve,  
 The commemorative bricks will stop melting within 10 days each  
 time the user enters the space,  
 If no one visits for a long time, it will eventually be completely inte-  
 grated after 180 days,
