Welcome to Dystopian Social Rules Lab. Now, each of you is a social consciousness.

You need to create a social 'orderliness' to achieve a logically self-consistent Dystopian society, which would be an endless cycle from which there is no escape.

A Dystopian society is capable of changing people into machines for social purposes by controlling their minds and eliminating their individuality.

Now, you need to complete this process:

- 1. Think about the purpose of the society you are building (what kind of society you want to achieve) (e.g. stability, chaos, keeping people's shoes off, keeping people from smiling, keeping people from eating apples).
- 2. No need to consider individuals' subjective initiative or opinions, think about how you will make rules to control people to achieve the society you want to build.
- 3. When the individual's spiritual consciousness arises, think about how you will destroy it so society reverts to the mechanical system.

You need to complete a Manifesto and a Social Sculpture as you see fit.

What you have before you is a series of elements, divided into two areas, in each of which you have to choose at least one or more elements, as inspiration, structure, or component parts. You could recreate them with reasons.

Orderliness, not Order.

Orderliness should be an endless circle of solidity, a cornerstone of flow, and a force to overcome strength with softness.

Before controlling being exposed, take into account as many recurring factors as possible, in order to form a closed circle of thinking logic, in which case the society will not perish even if a rebellion takes place, because this closed circle of thinking will always control the people in this line of thinking. Constantly rebel, repeatedly establish the same system, repeatedly rebel, repeatedly establish the same system, repeatedly rebel...... When rebellion is internalized into the system structure of "orderliness", it changes an indeterminate factor into a stable one.

Most of the time, the perspective is focused on rebellion as a member of an oppressed Dystopian society.

Sometimes it seems to be assumed that rebellion is the end of an absurd society.

However, a successful Dystopian society should anticipate people's rebellion and anticipate how to deal with it.

Is what we call subversion really subversive? What if your shallow rebellion is already taken into account?

This time, as a party to the oppression of a Dystopian society, to observe observe yourself, observe others, observe the composition of society. Think actively as a creator, as a controller, not accept passively as a victim, as a controlled person.

It is a stable trap, a nightmare that cannot be stopped, a constant battle: to us, to society, to humanity.

When these are all over, think of a way out of the dualistic rebellion, or use your knowledge to construct something - it's your choice. But, after you leave this room, this nightmare will still grab you from time

to time, make you think of it, make you think of it.
