


The second scenario we chose was the cleaning and fruit and vegetable sections of a supermarket, two areas where women often buy and which are also related to household




For our third scenario, we chose a café, a place where people can read and interact properly.



No frame. New eyes. From dark. Find light.


Hug air. Laugh loud. Breathe deep. Dance wild
