## Supermarket

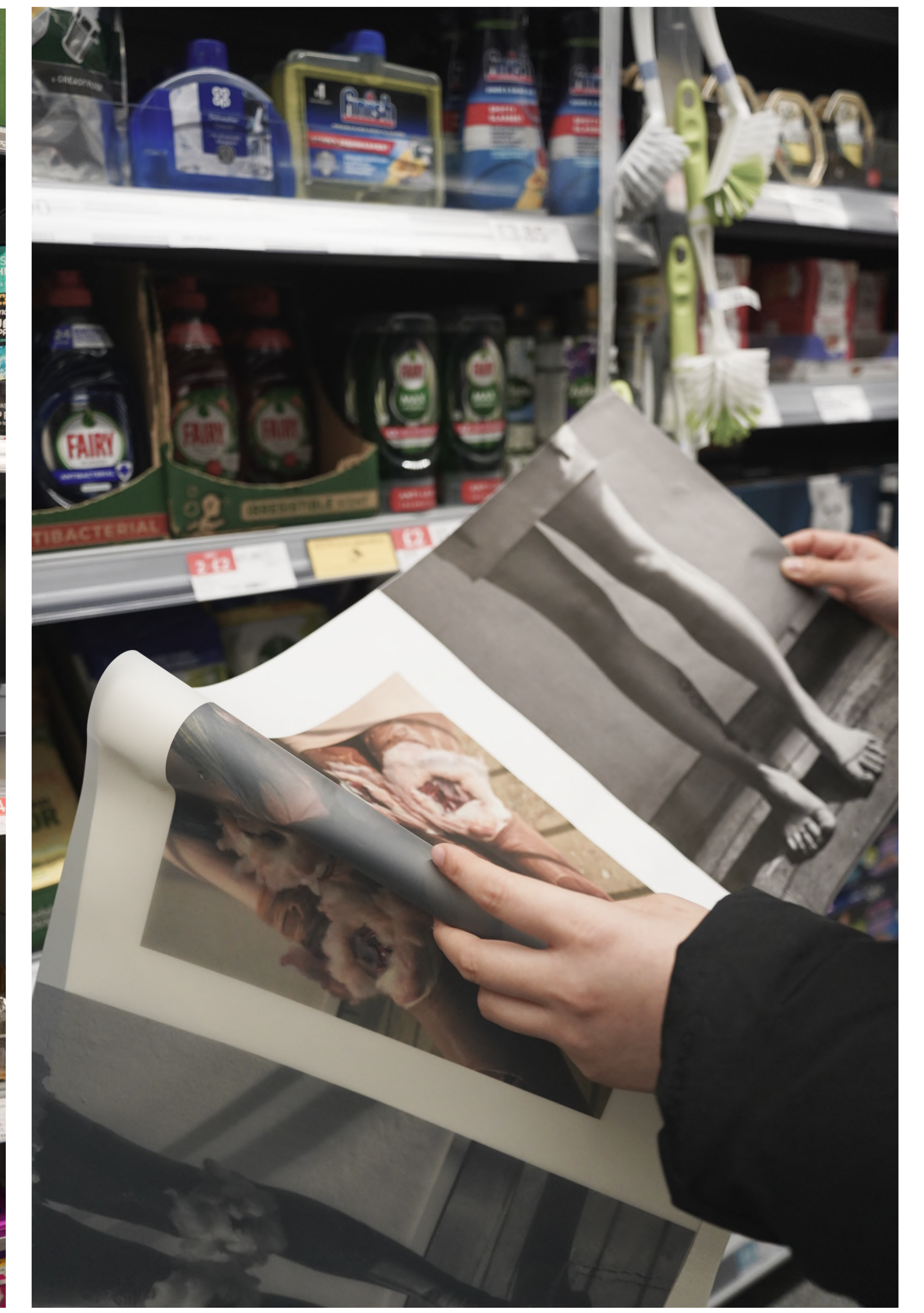
The second scenario we chose was the cleaning and fruit and vegetable sections of a supermarket, two areas where women often buy and which are also related to household chores.

Cleaning Area



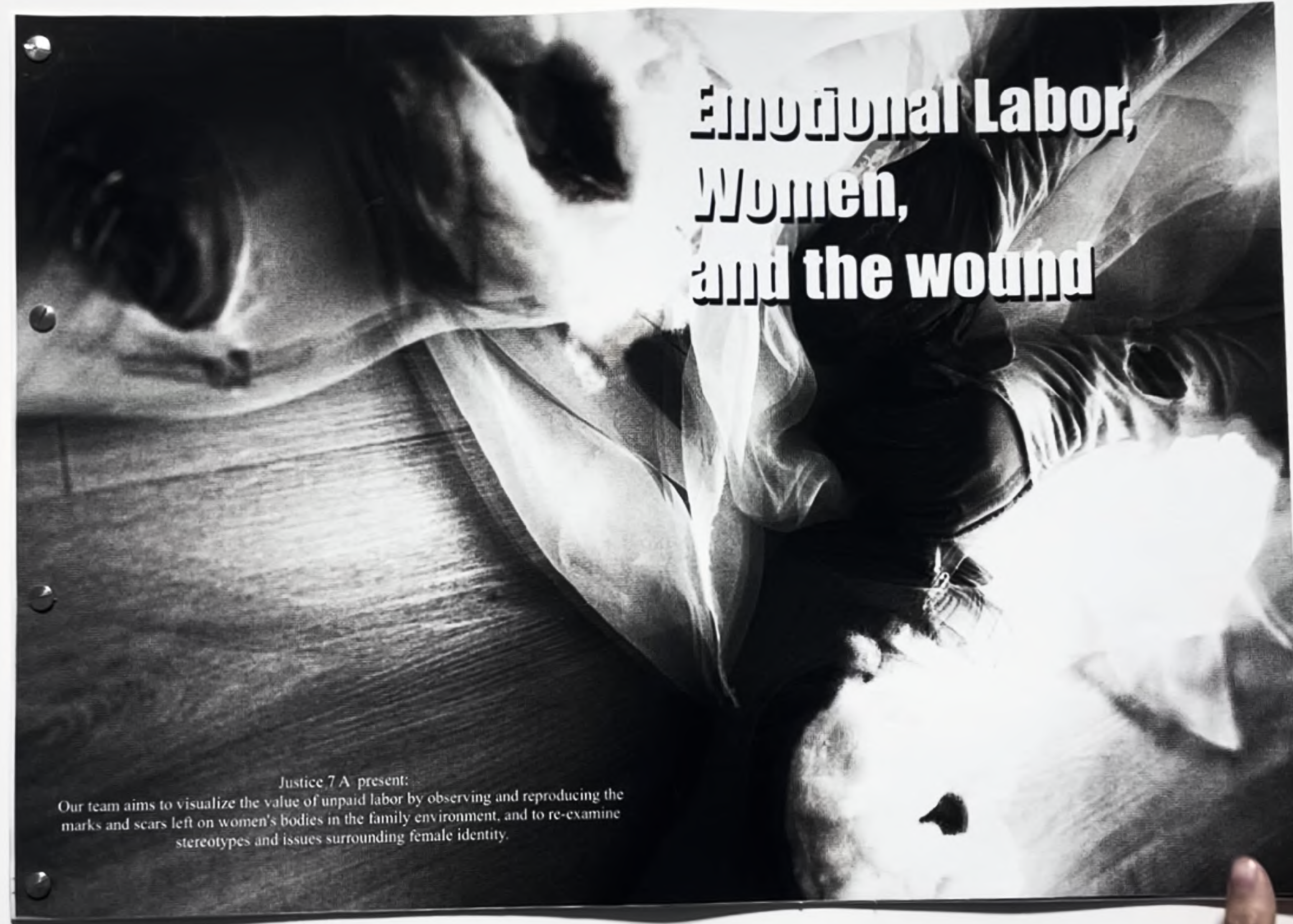

## Cafe

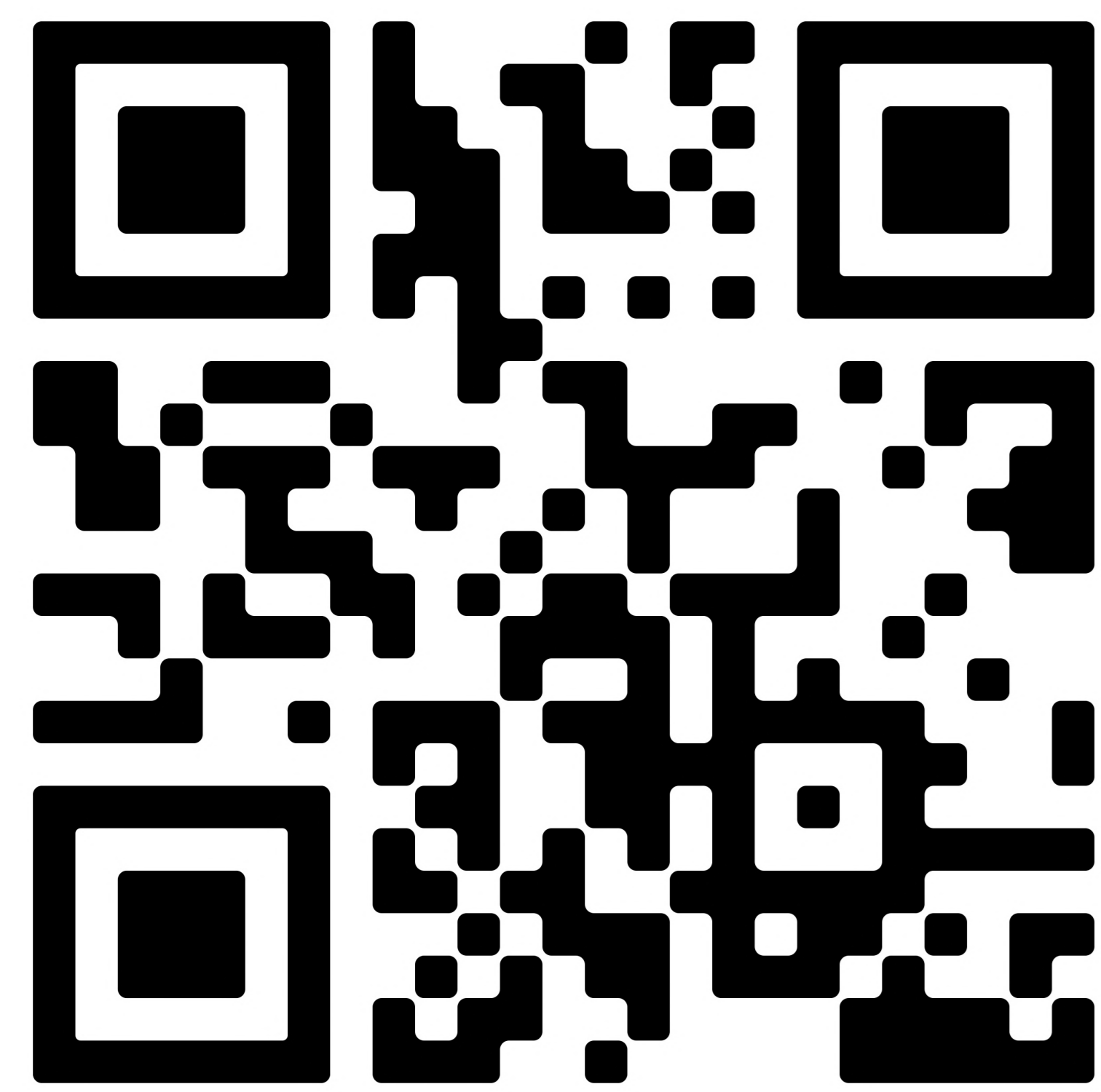
For our third scenario, we chose a café, a place where people can read and interact properly.



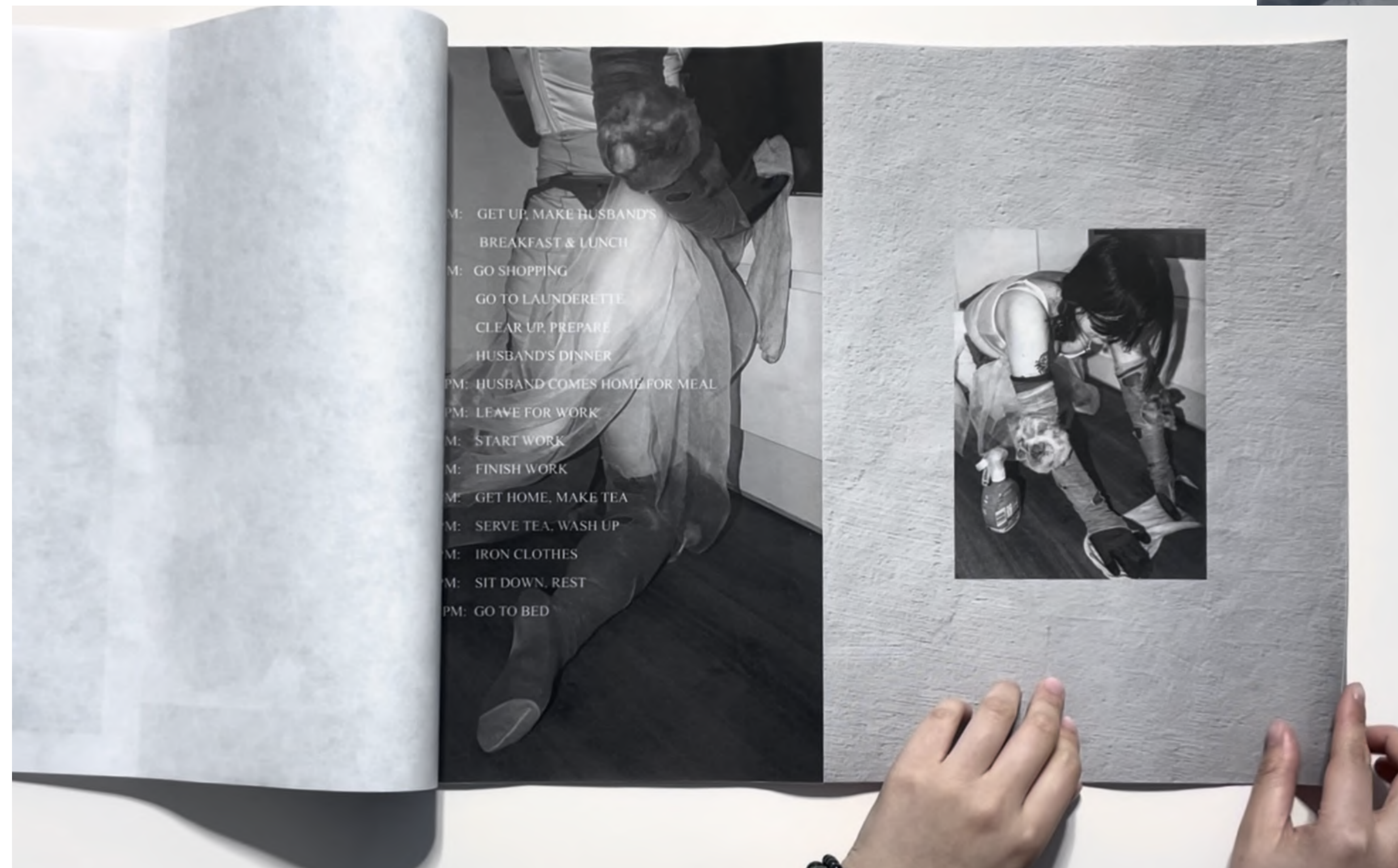

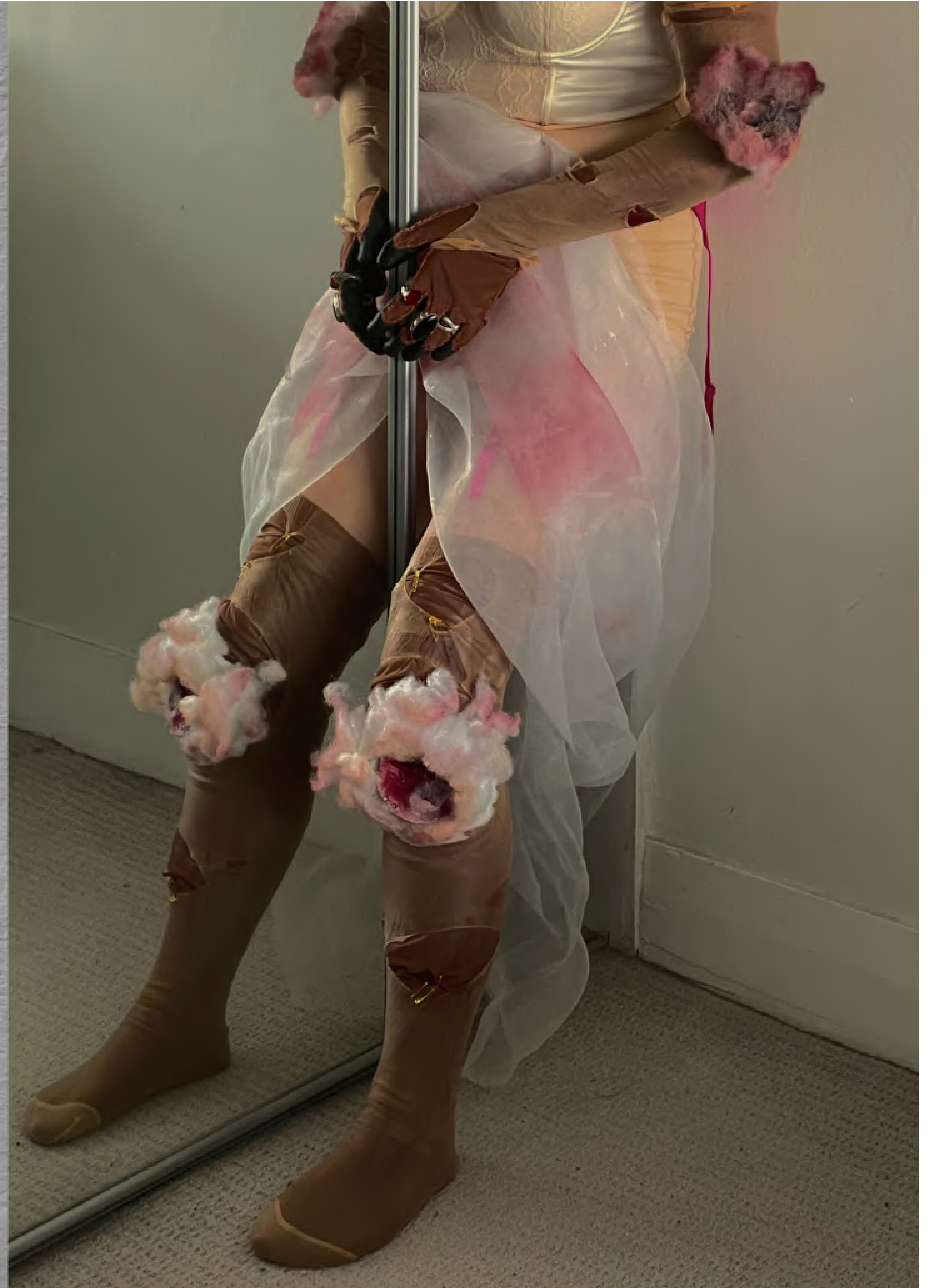

Breathe deep. Dance wild

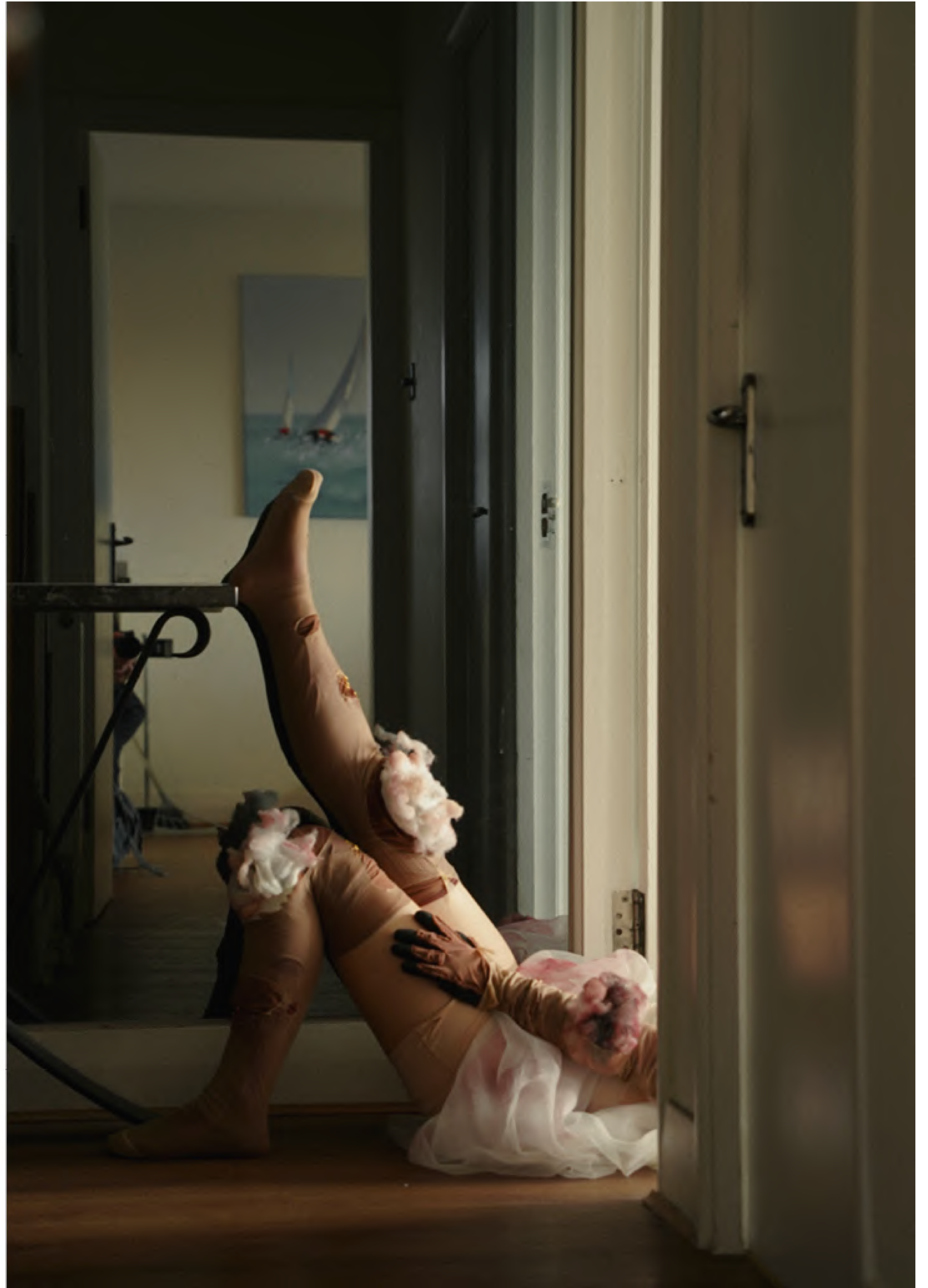
Ask cloud. Ask wind.
