






Introduction

What causes body image shame?



22% UK adults

said the images on social media will make them feel body image anxiety

What is in a Like?

16% will judge themselves based on the number of likes. 10.5%

What is in a Like?

Gain recognition through likes

People want to gain recognition through the number of likes, so more likes means being recognized by more people.

Unavoidable herd behavior

People often follow trends because others do the same. Especially with posts receiving many likes and positive comments. Therefore, the underlying reason for this behavior is the fear of missing out (FOMO).

Single aesthetic standards

When a style got more likes, people's definition of beauty changes accordingly, leading to the formation of a singular aesthetic.

How Might We help people in their 20s realise their body image is unique rather than impacted by more likes posted on social media?



Art therapy

Individuals can better express their understanding and feelings about their own image through painting, thereby alleviating body anxiety and improving self-acceptance.

Color theory is the study of how colors work together and how they affect our emotions and perceptions.


As we encounter situations in our daily life, our memory is shaped by some of these experiences and our brain associates emotions to them.

Users can access the website and play the coloring game without the need for downloading and installing, regardless of the device they use.


Developer perspective

Social perspective


Web-based games can attract more women worldwide who are concerned about body image. They can personalize colors to create their own models, reaching a wider audience. How do we avoid showing biased body image?










Why abstract painting?
