Make a Family Tree

Create a family tree craft to show who makes up your family.

Materials:

- Green and Brown Construction Paper
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Markers
- 1. Use the green construction paper and a pencil to trace the hand of each member of your family.
- 2. Cut out each hand print.
- 3. Create the trunk of your tree from brown or black construction paper. A simple long rectangle will do.
- 4. Use the glue to glue the green hands to the top. You want to branch them out so they look like a nice and full tree.
- 5. Use the markers to start writing on the tree branches the various members of the family. Or you can draw a picture of all the people who make up your family.
