


<p>Porcupine Play-Doh</p>  <p>Watch this video tutorial</p>	<p>Create your own porcupine friend like the one in the story!</p> <p>Materials:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Brown Play-Doh • Paper • Pen • Scissors • Spaghetti <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Take your brown play-doh and form it into a small ball 2. Pinch one side of the play-doh ball to form a pointed nose for your porcupine 3. Cut out two small circles from your paper for the eyes 4. Use your pen to draw two dots in the center of each eye 5. Place the two eyes on your porcupine 6. Use about 3-inch pieces of uncooked spaghetti to place in the back of the porcupine.
<p>Retelling</p>	<p>Use your new porcupine friend to retell the events that happened in the story! Ask questions like:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What animal friends did the porcupine meet? • What was the porcupine asking for? • How would it feel if you would hug a porcupine?
<p>Add a Page to the Story!</p>	<p>Let's extend the story and add another page! Think of another animal that the porcupine can ask for a hug. What would the animal's answer be?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use a blank piece of paper to write: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ "I need a hug. Will you cuddle me, _____?" ○ Add the animal's name into the blank space. • Draw a picture to go along with the extra page.
