

Little Roja Riding Hood

In today's story, Little Roja Riding Hood is on a mission to bring soup to her grandmother. Now, we have an activity for you to make some alphabet soup that you can share with your family!

Recipe for Alphabet Soup

Ingredients:

- Paper
- Child-safe scissors
- Glue or tape
- Something to color with

Instructions:

- 1. First, let's make a bowl for your soup. Draw a large circle on your piece of paper and color it in with whatever color you would like your soup to be!
- 2. There are a couple ways to add the alphabet to your soup:
 - a. Option 1: if you know your alphabet, write all the letters inside your bowl.
 - b. Option 2: if you are learning your alphabet, you can print out <u>this worksheet</u>, trace the letters, and cut the rectangles out. Then, using your glue or tape, you can add the alphabet to your soup.
 - c. Option 3: if you are looking for a challenge, you can write out the letters in "bubble" form on a separate sheet of paper, color them in, and then cut them out. Then, using your glue or tape, you can add your custom letters to your soup.
 - d. Bonus idea: with all these options, you can create a message for your family using letters of the alphabet!
- 3. Once you are done making your soup, let it "cool down" (let the glue dry) and then share with your family! Hope you enjoyed the alphabet soup!!
