Hatching Chicks	Create your own chick or <i>pollito</i> to retell the story together!
Craft	Materials:
	Two paper plates

	Orange paper
	Crayon or google eyes
140	Feathers (optional)
	Scissors
	• Glue

	1. Use the yellow paper to cut out an oval and a circle for the chick's body
	and head. Glue the bottom of the circle to the top of the oval.
	2. Use the orange paper to cut out a small diamond shape. Fold the diamond
	in half. Glue half of the diamond on the chick at the center of the circle
	head for its beak.
	 Use the crayon or google eyes to make eyes on your chick. Use the feathers make wings by gluing them to the sides of the chick's oval
	body.
	5. To make the egg, cut one paper plate in half with jagged zig-zag cuts.
	6. Take half of the paper plate and turn it upside down onto the full paper
	plate. There should be a small pocket between the two plated. Glue the
	edges of the plates together.
	7. Line up the other half of the paper plate. Use the bracket or a piece of tape
	to secure one side of the top half and the full plate together. This will make
	a flap.
	8. Put your chick inside the egg. Make the sounds from the story as the chick
	emerges from it's shell! "Pio, pio, pio!"
