of LGBTQ+ employees report that being “out” at work could damage their career.

32% of people of color within the LGBTQ+ community faced discrimination in the work hiring process...

of surveyed LGBTQ+ Real Estate Alliance members report they signed legal forms (i.e., mortgage, purchase agreement, title, etc.) that did not adequately represent their life experience.

54.2% of surveyed LGBTQ+ Real Estate Alliance members report feeling concerned about facing discrimination if they eventually need to live in a senior housing facility.




Only 20.5% of surveyed LGBTQ+ Real Estate Alliance members who “came out” before 21 shared that their parents were extremely supportive.

This number jumps to 71.8% for those ages 55-64.


10.6%

of surveyed LGBTQ+ Real Estate Alliance members experienced a real estate professional discriminating against them in the renting/home buying process.

89% of surveyed Alliance members said that they find it at least somewhat important to live in an LGBTQ+ friendly community.
