(the "Contest")

Official Contest Rules (the "Rules")

REMAX® VIP Tickets Contest for REMAX Agents

Dates of contest: January 15, 2026 - March 15, 2026

The Contest is subject to all federal, provincial, and municipal laws. Void where prohibited.

1. Contest Sponsors: The Contest is sponsored by Toronto Home Shows LP. This Contest will be run in accordance with these Rules, subject to amendment by Toronto Home Shows LP. Entrants must comply with these Rules, and, by entering the Contest, will be deemed to have received, understood and accepted the Rules.
2. Contest Period: The Contest starts at 12:00 AM (Eastern Daylight Time) on January 15<sup>th</sup>, 2026 and continues until 11:59 PM (Eastern Daylight Time) on March 15th, 2026 (the "Contest Period").
3. Eligibility: The Contest is only open to licensed REMAX agents who are legal residents of Canada (excluding residents of Quebec) and at least 18 years of age or older. Employees of Toronto Home Shows LP and its parent and affiliated companies and subsidiaries, and immediate family members of any such person (regardless of where they live) or those with whom any such persons are domiciled are not eligible to enter the Contest. Entries are limited to individuals only; commercial enterprises and business entities are not eligible to enter the Contest.
4. How to Enter: Any REMAX agent who participates in the 2026 National Home Show REMAX VIP Tickets Program is automatically entered. All entries must be accompanied by the entrant's name, phone number, email and mailing address.
5. Entrant Identity: If the identity of an entrant is disputed, the authorized account holder of the e-mail address submitted at the time of entry will be deemed to be the entrant. The individual assigned to the submitted e-mail address is considered the authorized account holder.
6. Prize: Ten (10) prizes available, each consisting of a \$100 VISA gift card, will be awarded to the Top 10 REMAX Agents based on the total number of redeemed and paid for REMAX VIP Tickets at the 2026 National Home Show. The Prize must be accepted as awarded and is not substitutable, transferable or convertible to cash. The prize winners will be chosen and will receive the prize via electronic gift certificate.
7. Winner Determination: The winners will be selected on or around March 31st, 2026 at Toronto Home Shows LP 's office at 99 Atlantic Ave, Suite 400, Toronto, Ontario from all eligible entries received during the Contest Period. Toronto Home Shows LP will contact the selected entrants using the e-mail address provided to enter the Contest. If the selected entrant does not acknowledge winner notification attempts within forty-eight (48) hours after Toronto Home Shows LP 's first attempt at contact or, if contacted, does not claim his/her Prize, or does not meet all of the Contest conditions outlined in these

Rules, the selected entrant will be disqualified and forfeits his/her Prize. Upon disqualification and forfeiture by the initially selected entrant, another entrant may be selected from among all remaining eligible entries whom Toronto Home Shows LP will attempt to contact, and who will be subject to disqualification and forfeiture in the same manner. This process will continue until contact is made with a selected entrant who meets Contests requirements or until there are no more eligible entries, whichever comes first. Toronto Home Shows LP is not responsible for failed attempts to notify any selected entrant. Upon prize forfeiture, no compensation will be given.

Toronto Home Shows LP will not be responsible for the use and/or consumption of the products awarded in the Contest. The winner may or may not use the products at their own discretion, if they so choose. Toronto Home Shows LP assumes no liability.

8. **Prize Substitution:** The Prize is non-exchangeable, non-transferable, and non-refundable, has no cash-surrender value, and must be accepted as awarded with no substitutions. Toronto Home Shows LP reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to substitute and/or modify the Prize with a prize or prizes of equal or greater value to the substituted or modified Prize for any reason.
9. **Winner Conditions:** To be declared a winner, a selected entrant must first: (i) have complied with, be in compliance with, and continue to comply with the Rules; (ii) correctly answer, unaided, a time-limited, mathematical skill-testing question to be administered by Contest Sponsor; and (iii) if required by Toronto Home Shows LP, sign and return a Declaration and Release form within a specified period of time confirming compliance with the Contest Rules and releasing the Releasees (as defined below) from liability in connection with the Contest. If the selected entrant fails to correctly answer the mathematical skill testing question or fails to sign and return a Declaration and Release form as required or is otherwise ineligible, the selected entrant will be considered to have forfeited the Prize and an alternate entrant will be selected in the manner described above. The alternate entrant will be subject to these same winner conditions. This process will continue until a selected entrant meets all winner conditions or until there are no more eligible entries, whichever comes first.

Any attempt by any entrant to obtain more than the stated maximum number of entries by using multiple/different names, email addresses, identities, registrations and logins, or any other methods will void that person's entries and eligibility to win the Prize and that participant will be disqualified from the Contest. Any use of robotic, repetitive, automatic, programmed or similar entry methods or agents (including, but not limited to, contest entry services) will void all entries by that entrant. 11. **Modification/Termination:** Subject to applicable law, Toronto Home Shows LP reserves the right, in their sole discretion and without liability, to terminate or suspend the Contest in whole or in part, or modify the Rules of the Contest at any time without notice if fraud, technical failures including any network server or hardware failure, viruses, bugs, errors in programming, or communications or any other errors or other causes beyond the control of Toronto Home Shows LP corrupts the administration, integrity or security of the Contest or if any other factor interferes with the conduct of this Contest as contemplated by these Rules, or for any other reason at the sole discretion of Toronto Home Shows LP.
12. **Privacy:** By entering this contest, each entrant expressly consents to Toronto Home Shows LP , its agents and/or representatives, storing, sharing, and using the personal information submitted with his/her entry only for the purpose of administering the Contest and in accordance with Toronto Home Shows LP 's Privacy Policy found at <https://torontohomeshows.com/privacy-policy/>, unless the entrant otherwise agrees.
13. **Publicity:** By accepting the Prize, the winner agrees that Toronto Home Shows LP and its designees may use his/her name, photographs, videos, likenesses, city of residence, biographical information, Prize information and/or statements about this Contest for advertising and/or publicity purposes in any and all media (now or hereafter known) throughout the world, in perpetuity without compensation, notification, or permission, unless otherwise prohibited by law.

The venue shall only be Toronto, Ontario. The invalidity or unenforceability of any provision of these Rules shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision. If any provision is determined to be invalid or otherwise unenforceable, these Rules shall be construed in accordance with their terms as if the invalid or unenforceable provision was not contained therein.
