

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR YOUR UPCOMING VASCULAR PROCEDURE

- <u>SHOWER</u> SHOWER BEFORE you come in for your procedure. <u>DO NOT</u> use any lotions, powders, or scented sprays afterwards.
- <u>Transportation</u> Please make sure you have someone to take you home. The medications you receive during your procedure can make it unsafe to drive or get home on your own.
- <u>FOOD</u> DO NOT eat or drink after midnight. You may take morning medications with a sip of water (EXCEPT for Eliquis, Xarelto, and Warfarin please see below)

## If Procedure is schedule at or after 12 noon, you may have a light Breakfast by 6am

- <u>MEDICATION</u> IF you are on a <u>BLOOD THINNER</u> (Eliquis, Xarelto, or Warfarin) please make sure your provider is aware.
  - For Eliquis *HOLD* 4 doses (2 days) prior to procedure
  - For Xarelto HOLD 2 doses prior to procedure
  - For Warfarin *HOLD* 3 doses prior to procedure
  - For Pradaxa HOLD 4 doses (2 days) prior to procedure

## IF you are <u>DIABETIC</u>:

- If you take Insulin, adjust your dose to ½ dose the night before your procedure.
  <u>HOLD</u> morning of procedure.
- If taking Metformin/Glucophage, <u>HOLD</u> the night before your procedure AND the day of your procedure
- If taking oral medication for your diabetes other than Metformin/Glucophage, <u>HOLD</u> morning of procedure.
