



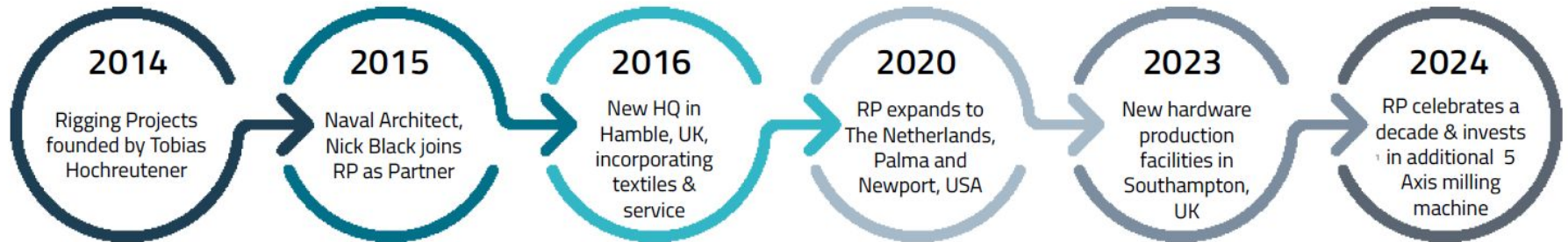

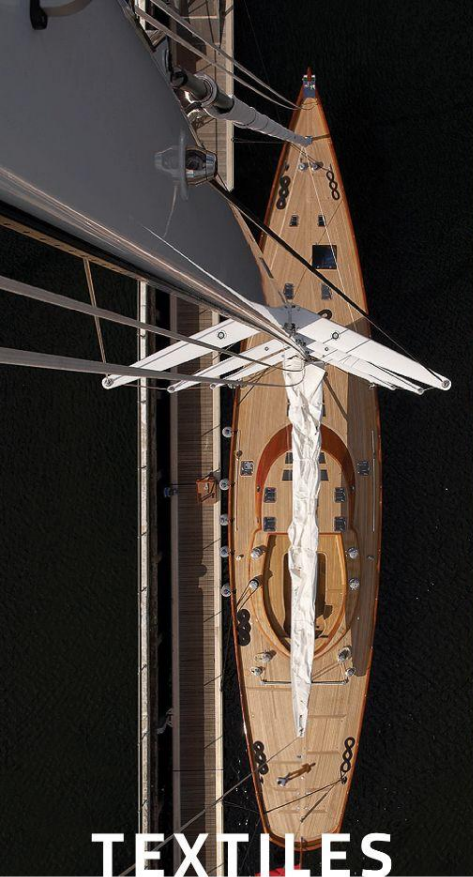

Our Textile division supplies loops, strops and cordage to some of the most high end superyachts and race yachts in the world.



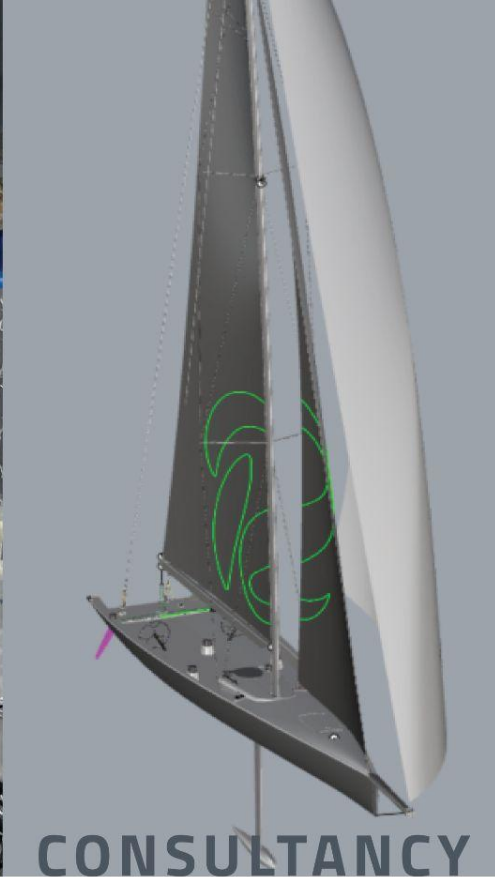
HARDWARE

TEXTILES

Rigging Projects Ltd specialises in the supply of **bespoke textile solutions** for the leisure marine industry. We pride ourselves on our excellent line specification, finishing detail and global after sales support with multiple service capabilities worldwide.

In addition to being active sailors themselves, our production team all have vast experience in supplying textile components to Grand Prix teams and a variety of high profile superyacht clients.

From initial specification through to installation and beyond, our attention to detail and customer service has resulted in long-standing relationships with our clients.



LINES

Our excellent relationship with industry leading rope manufacturers such as Gottifredi Maffioli and Marlow dates back over 15 years, with other suppliers also considered.

We strongly believe that no one supplier covers all aspects of a client led package requirement and our prerogative is to provide our clients with bespoke, custom line solutions that meet the performance and aesthetic demands of their yachts.



LINE OPTIONS

- Range of cover materials that can be adjusted to suit the application and handling requirements
- Machine tapering of lines to reduce the weight, handling and storage requirements of line tails.
- Variable braiding tension in the line cover to ensure it is kept as tight as possible and tolerance is only introduced at the splice section.
- Lines that are specifically designed for use on captive winches with grip inserts to reduce movement between core and cover.
- Highly customisable colour options so we can work with the client to develop a line package that complements the yacht's aesthetics.
- Custom flecks to either match aesthetics again or numerical coding applications like reefing lines (1, 2 and 3 fleck pictured top right).
- Diameter increases for better grip or handling in clutch's and winches.



STROPS

In the last decade we have supplied over 6,000 textile strops for a variety of clients and applications. Each item is custom designed to match the load, length and configuration requirements of the application.

Months of product testing has allowed us to build up an extensive catalogue of real-life break testing data. This allows us to specify the construction of each item to ensure adequate safety factors with 100% confidence for loads to 200T+. On key rigging textile components, where required, we can carry out additional certified independent proof testing to specific classification standards.

- Deck Hardware Connections
- Halyard Lock Strops
- Sheet Connections
- Tender Lifting





DOCK LINES

Our bespoke packages also cover mooring and towing solutions. This includes:

- Customised lengths, spec and finishing details
- Tapered dock lines for easier handling (26mm upwards)
- Tapered Towline assemblies for long range towing
- Floating and reflective shore lines
- Bollard Stretcher Loops
- Anchor Bridle and Snubbers

TENDER LIFTING

As standard, most tenders are supplied with cumbersome lifting bridles made from metal chain links, snap shackles, and bulky polyester webbing strops. At Rigging Projects, we offer sleek Tender Lifting Bridle Assemblies featuring dyneema loops and strops with soft-eye dogbone connections, eliminating metal-on-metal contact and reducing the risk of damage to paintwork, upholstery and sponsons.

For a seamless aesthetic, the strop cover colour can be customised to complement the tender or yacht. Additionally, all strops are proof-loaded to meet coding regulations.

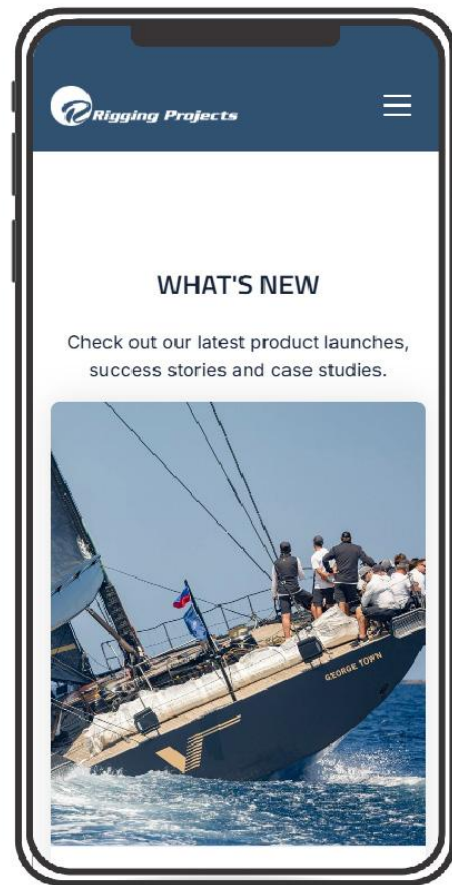
THE RP APP

Our new **Aftersales App** has launched in 2025, enabling yacht crews to have instant access to all the information relating to their running rigging & hardware packages. By creating a yacht login, any member of the crew can check the following by scanning the barcode on the RP product:

- Line specifications - length, manufacturer, application, colour, braid type etc.
- Textile Strop specifications - date of manufacture, load, application, testing information.
- Textile service schedule – installation date and when it should be replaced or inspected.

Missing service dates can lead to dangerous and costly breakages and the RP App will send you and your crew alerts when services are due, enabling remote inspection reports that we can sign off for you via the app and easy spares and replacement ordering when the time comes.

The App is not limited to RP products and can be used to track any product onboard, including 3rd party hardware and standing rigging. Using dynamic barcoding you can set service alerts on your rigging and store manufacturer details and manuals.
