Preparing for Tax Season

We begin preparing business tax returns in January and personal tax returns the first of February. It is important to ensure that we have your most up-to date information ahead of time. Our Online Tax Return Services- Form 1040

Almost all of our clients are paperless and using online tax return services (online Client Organizer, online delivery of tax returns, and e-filing), if you are not, we hope you'll give it a try this tax season.

E-filing is now mandated by the IRS and most states. All returns that can be e-filed will be e-filed.

As with all tax returns, paperless or otherwise, your W-2s, 1099s, and other documentation listed in the Organizer still need to be delivered to our office before we can begin to process returns. Those documents allow us to verify your entries and among other things ensure deductions allowed are being taken advantage of.

You'll need to sign an authorization form and ensure it is in our office before it is time to e-file your return(s) as we cannot e-file without your signed permission. The forms can be signed electronically, scanned and emailed, faxed or delivered to us.

In Closing

Tax regulations are always changing, and we are staying up-to date on all the current fluctuations. Call on us to make sure you aren't caught off guard by any of these alterations.
