

Terms and Conditions

Information on how to enter this competition and prize details form part of these Terms and Conditions.

Entry Information

- A maximum of one entry per person or team will be accepted. The Promoters reserve the right to exclude an entrant from the competition if it is suspected that an entrant has made more than one entry.
- The Opening Date for entries is 09:00 AEST on the 1st September 2022. The Closing Date for entries is 23:59 AEST on the 31st October 2022. Entries received after this time will NOT be considered in the competition.
- The Promoters accept no responsibility for competition entries that are not successfully completed, submitted, or received by the Closing Date for any reason, including, for example, due to a technical fault or other equipment failure of any kind.
- Your entry must be your own original work – except where the author is clearly stated, and content reproduced with permission.
- Your entry must not:
 - Violate any third-party rights including, but not limited to: copyright, trademark rights, or rights of publicity and privacy; or
 - Contain defamatory statements, include threats to any person, group, or business, or be obscene or indecent.

Personal Information
