

SPILL READINESS COURSES

LEVEL 1—FOUNDATION—BASIC SPILL KIT TRAINING (55 MINUTES)

This course is suitable for any individual who handles liquids as part of their day-to-day activities and are required to use spill kits and absorbents to deal with day to day 'incidental' spills and leaks around the workplace. This course is ideal as an introduction to the topic of spill response in the workplace.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

1. To provide operatives with the information necessary to allow them to safely use spill products that you provide them with on your site.
2. To highlight the importance of having a simple, effective, response action plan
3. To stress the importance of preventing spillage escape and the impact from environmental pollution

LEVEL 2—INTERMEDIATE— FIRST RESPONDER TRAINING (210 MINUTES)

This course is an advancement to our level 1 course. BSIF accredited and ideal for individuals who may act as first responder to liquid spills. It can be held at one of your own facilities or at our training facility in Rotherham.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

1. To provide an improved level of response to emergency spills and to reduce both risks and corporate exposure from polluting the environment.
2. To improve individual knowledge and understanding around the physical dangers of spillage, typical routes of escape from site and how to safely use containment and absorbent products to control a spill safely and effectively.
3. To create awareness around individuals moral and legal responsibilities for causing pollution as a consequence of spillages entering the water environment.

LEVEL 3—ADVANCED—TRAIN THE TRAINER TRAINING (APPROX 240 MINUTES)

This course is for up to 4 competent key personnel or you're in-company trainers. This course will enable the trainer to deliver a competent level 1 Basic Spill Kit course to work colleagues who may be called upon to deal with day-to-day spills. It will enable trainers to effectively demonstrate simple spill response methodology via a practical "dry" product demonstration.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

1. To provide trainers with an adequate level of subject knowledge.
2. To impart confidence to train colleagues to achieve a safe level of spill response.
3. To demonstrate understanding and proper use of all site spill response equipment
