Students can request to bring their own digital device (BYOD) to college.

Definition of “Technology”

For the purposes for BYOD, “Technology” refers to any privately-owned wireless and/or portable electronic device. The approved BYOD are:

- Laptop
- Chromebook

Internet

The device must be connected to our network by our IT staff, and our college network filters will be applied to the device.

Security and Damage

The college will not be liable for any damage or loss of a device. Insurance for the device must be held by the family. Students will be responsible for the transport of the device and safe use of it while learning.

The college has the right to examine any device that is suspected of causing problems.

Student Agreement

The use of BYOD for learning at college is a privilege. Students can only use the device for educational purposes. Students will need to adhere to the User Device Agreement as well as the BYOD Student Agreement while using their device.

Information Storage

Files created for learning will need to be saved to the device, an external drive or the cloud. Students will not have access to printing from their personal device.

It is important that students do not share files. This may break Copyright rules, as well as increase the possibility of moving viruses between devices.
