Captain Sam Torrance opened the final-day singles matches with what he believed were his best seven players and got more support than he had imagined, as Europe scored a stunning 15½-to-12½ victory at The Belfry. The win was Europe's sixth in nine matches.

Delayed one year by the 9/11 terrorist attacks, the Ryder Cup retained its penchant for drama. Europe's Paul McGinley made a 6-foot putt on No. 18 to earn a halve against Jim Furyk, assuring Europe the 14½ points it needed to claim the Cup. Phil Mickelson, the No. 2 player in the world and second-to-last in the lineup, missed an 18-inch putt early in his match and was routed by Phillip Price of Wales, ranked 119th in the world. Tiger Woods, suffering from a high fever, never had a chance to contribute: He was on the 17th hole when the loudest roar of the week indicated the Ryder Cup was over. Colin Montgomerie, unbeaten in all five of his matches, hit leadoff in singles and quickly dispatched Scott Hoch, 5 and 4.
