Privacy Policy

1. San Antonio RoadRunners (SARR) places a high priority on protecting your privacy. This privacy policy was created in order to demonstrate SARR's firm commitment to the privacy of our members and website users. This policy explains what types of information is collected by SARR's website. Our website is hosted by RunSignup at <https://runsignup.com/saroadrunners>. It can also be accessed using the domain names <http://saroadrunners.org> and <http://saroadrunners.com> owned by San Antonio RoadRunners (which redirect to <https://runsignup.com/saroadrunners>). San Antonio RoadRunners also owns and operates a website at <https://sarracelist.org> which is used primarily to manage our volunteer program and various other support programs.

2. The SARR website contains links to other sites. Please be aware that SARR is not responsible for the privacy practices of other websites. We encourage our users to take appropriate precautions when leaving our website and to read the privacy statements of each website that collects personally identifiable information. This privacy statement applies solely to information collected by SARR.

3. WHAT INFORMATION IS COLLECTED FROM YOU AND HOW IT IS USED:

No registration is required to read the public parts of the SARR website. Only authorized representatives of SARR may post information or materials on the SARR public website. Only SARR members may access the private SARR sections of the website. Only authorized SARR representatives may post materials there.

SARR collects information from our members and website users in a variety of ways.

SARR collects and tracks information on volunteer hours including volunteer name, email address, and a history of volunteer efforts resulting in the award of volunteer points. Volunteer points are used to reward volunteers with the opportunity to exchange volunteer points for race and training discounts.

As part of registering for membership, events, volunteer opportunities, and other activities, SARR collects contact information such as, but not limited to, name, address, phone number, age, gender, and email address. We may use third-party sites, such as RunSignup.com to collect this information. Please refer to the Privacy Policy of these third-party sites to understand their data uses and restrictions. SARR

may use this information for scoring/timing and for proof of registration as well as for communications with members and past participants regarding future events, training and monthly newsletters.

4. SARR is required to share contact information on all SARR officers with the Internal Revenue Service.
5. SARR complies with all applicable federal and state laws and regulations governing security procedures and breach of security procedures. This website takes every reasonable precaution to protect users' information. When users submit sensitive information via the website, the information is protected both on- and off-line.
6. We make every reasonable effort to protect users' information on-line and off-line. Access to users' information is restricted in our organization. Only those persons who need the information to perform their tasks are granted access to personally identifiable information. All officers and key volunteers are kept up to date on our security and privacy practices.
7. Members may opt-out of various communications by emailing membership@saroadrunners.com and request non-mailing status.
8. If a member's information changes, we will endeavor to provide a way to correct, or update the information. This can usually be done utilizing the online facilities provided on the SARR website or by emailing membership@saroadrunners.com.
9. If SARR changes its privacy policy, we will post a notice of change on the homepage of our website for at least seven days so our users are aware of what information we collect, how we use it, and under what circumstances, if any, we disclose it. If at any point SARR decides to use personally identifiable information in a manner different from that stated at the time it was collected, users will have a choice whether to consent to such use. We will use information in accordance with the privacy policy under which the information was collected.
