**INTERESTING FACTS:**

Oldest 10K in San Antonio.

1974 – At the request of the San Antonio Fiesta Commission,  
SARR joined the Commission.

1974 – 2019 – Classified as an Official Fiesta event  
Held the first Saturday of Fiesta

Per Ernie Oakes:

1976: First year with a Mission 10k t-shirt.

1978: Total entries was 2703. This may still be the record of participants for a run solely sponsored by SARR.

1981: The overall female winner with a time of 40:02 was Stephanie Paparelli in the 11 and under age group.

1982: “One year the run was almost 8 miles due to an SA Policeman leading the runners the wrong way due to his having the course map from the previous year.” Per Al Lanctot, Race Director, this error occurred in 1982.

Per October, 1982, SARR Newsletter: “there was a discussion regarding the course. Most of the members present do not like the course. It is held at Mission Park simply because it has always been there. The consensus was that the new Race Director(s) could use an alternate course if they chose to.”

1983 and 1984: The race director of the Fiesta Mission 10k opted to make it a 12k. It wasn't a surprise as it was advertised as a 12k. Interestingly a misprint of the race entry form in 1984 had a map of the 20k course. Robert Yara won both runnings of the Fiesta Mission 12k.

Per Al Lanctot, Fiesta Mission 10K Race Director 1982-1984:

“**Runner's World** (Magazine) had an item in their May/June publication to the effect that everything was bigger in Texas and especially the length of the SARR 10K Fiesta Run which turned to be approximately 1 mile longer.”

“Olga Merkelz, Charles' wife, painted the tile with the Mission (possibly Mission San Jose) and gave those out to the winners.”

2012 race held at Alamo Heights Swimming Pool. About 15 minutes before race start, a residential fire was reported along the race route. Sally Rios, Volunteer Coordinator, and Jerry Negrete, Club President, rushed to change the route as well as move course marshals that were already in position.

2013 race started and finished at Mission County Park but part of the route was through the grounds of Mission San Jose. Sally Rios worked closely with the Park Rangers in getting permission to have the race go through the Mission grounds. No signs/chalk/water stops were allowed inside the grounds. Volunteers were used to direct the runners in and out of the grounds.

2014 race held at Brooks Air Force Base. About five minutes before race start, Brooks officials as well as SAPD officials advised Jerry Negrete, Club President, that part of the route needed to be changed. Jerry, who was driving the officials along the race course prior to the event, immediately contacted the race director to delay the start. Fortunately, only one water stop had to be moved as a result of this last minute change.

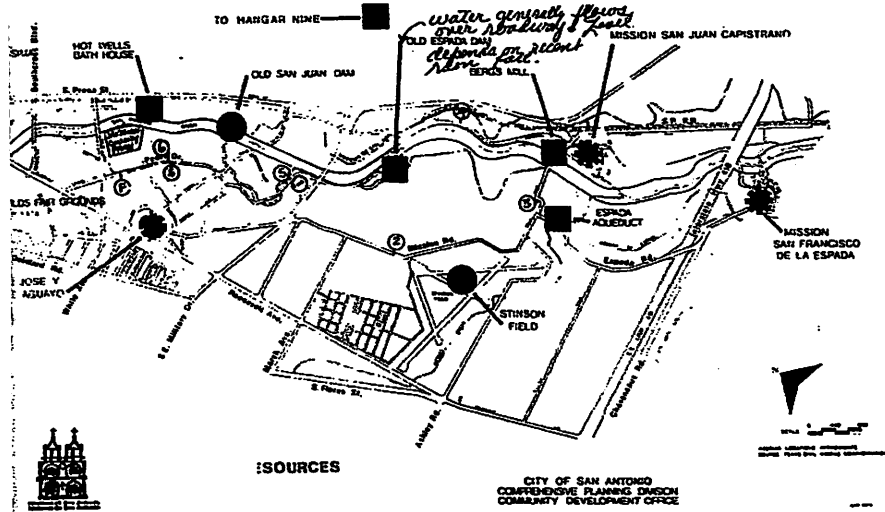

The 10,000 meter Fiesta Mission Run in late spring each year is just one of hundreds of special events built around San Antonio's annual Fiesta. The 87th annual Fiesta to be held in 1982 will offer a cornucopia of food, fun, festivals, and parades spread over nine days in Mardi Gras style.

Highlighting the Fiesta San Antonio are the coronation of King Antonio, the King's River Parade, Battle of Flowers Parade, street dancing, a carnival, concerts, and A Night In Old San Antonio. The latter is a Fiesta standard attracting more than 100,000 people during its four nights of culture, cuisines, and atmosphere at Old Town (La

Villita). Similarly, at Market Square, there are 10 days of fun and food, music, and street dancing. Last April, several million people attended Fiesta.

Parades include a Pilgrimage to the Alamo with pilgrims carrying floral offerings to the historic site, the Fiesta River Parade with dozens of gaily decorated barges winding their way down the river, Battle of Flowers, and Fiesta Flambeau, America's greatest night parade held on the final weekend of Fiesta. The Flambeau parade drew 300,000 spectators in April '81.

Fiesta also features concerts at the Alamo, a giant fireworks display, art shows, fairs on the banks of the San Antonio River, a writer's fiesta and a number of sporting events in addition to the

Every runner sustains at least one injury a year to the feet or legs, running the gamut from blisters to stress fractures. 60% of all sports injuries involve the feet and legs. 20 to 40% of all injuries seen by podiatrists involve the knee; 15% the heel, 5% to 10% affect the achilles tendon and forefoot, and 1% to 2% concern the hip and back.

10,000 meter run, including lacrosse and a bicycle race.

San Antonian Shawn Flanagan's record 30:40 withstood an assault this past April from David Renneisen, 25, from Laughlin Air Force Base in Del Rio. Renneisen, despite a heavy rain, splashed and stepped his way to a 30:47 clocking, just seven seconds off the Olympic qualifier's course record.

In the female competition, eight-year-old, pig-tailed Stephanie Paparelli surprised the field by running the 6.2-mile course in 40 minutes, 2 seconds. The San Antonioan's time fell a few minutes short of the best women's time ever recorded at the Fiesta 10,000, Peggy Kokernot, a celebrity on San Antonio's P.M. Magazine, holds the record, 37:25. Tiny Stephanie is a national record holder in the 10,000 meter run.

### KEYS TO THE COURSE

**DESCRIPTION:** Flat

**SURFACE:** Asphalt

**AID STATIONS:** At halfway point

**COURSE SUMMARY:** The Fiesta Mission course follows for the most part the route of the Mission Trails 10-Mile Run except it does not circle Mission San Francisco De La Espanada south of Loop 410. Like the 10-miler, the 10K race begins in south San Antonio at Mission County Park off White Avenue bordering the river. The course goes along Padre Drive for about a mile, takes sort of a U-turn to the west and picks up again on Mission Road. At about the two and one-half mile mark, runners will turn left onto Ashley Road and travel for about a mile before taking another left onto the Acequia de San Juan. Runners pass historic Mission San Juan Capistrano at the halfway point. About four and one-half miles into the run, runners must cross a low water crossing near the Old Espada Dam which is usually running with some water depending on recent rainfall. The course picks up on the northwest bank on Padre Drive paralleling the San Antonio River. There is a foot bridge to cross at the five-mile mark on Padre Drive. At two other spots, runners must cross the serpentine river and then continue on about another mile to the finish line on Padre Drive near Mission County Park.

The course is accurately measured and time splits given every mile. The race director says a "Fiesta mood permeates the event" which is well-supported by the San Antonio Police Department and the community.

## San Antonio RoadRunners Mission Race (April 1974 – current)

The San Antonio RoadRunners Mission race is Texas' oldest 10K race and was one of the inaugural events of the newly formed San Antonio RoadRunners (established May 1973).

This historic race was first held in April 1974, with runners finishing in the courtyard of Mission San Jose. The 5K and Kids' run were added over the last 10 years and in 2014 we began providing fiesta medals to finishers. In 1978, we had the largest number of participants ever recorded for this race, ~~2708~~ 2703

The race was founded by Charles Merkelz, a charter member of SARR who also served as the Mission Race Director for the first three years. The original entry fee was \$1 for the 10K and runners earned a patch but no t-shirt.

Ernie Oakes, an original and current SARR member, ran the first SARR Mission 10K and has participated yearly in some form or other as a runner, volunteer or director. He remembers finishing near or at any one of the nearby missions, on the road or in Mission County Park.

## FIESTA RUNS 1973 to 1998

Twenty five years ago the president of the SARR was Ken Bashore and one of his running buddies Charlie Merkelz had a great idea, "Lets have a 10 K run down through the Missions" All agreed that it was a great idea and, as is often the case, the guy with the good idea was made "in charge", Charlie Merkelz. The Fiesta Mission Run started as a good idea but with Charlie's effort and negotiating ability it soon became a authorized event not only with the National Park Department, which took over the Missions that same year, 1973, but also as it is today a "Scheduled Fiesta Event". That was no small step and the benefits are still enjoyed today by those of us, which make this an annual event through these religious and historical landmarks.

That first year the race started inside the courtyard of Mission San Jose, and followed a course down the mission trail. It passed through the courtyard of Mission San Juan, across the swinging bridge and then everyone had to get their feet wet when the course crossed the spillway of Estrada damn. It ended back through the church gate of Mission San Jose. That first year the race was more like a pilgrimage and for those, lucky enough to have participated, never to be forgotten.

Like every good race director Charlie had lots of help not the least of which was Olga a member of the River Art Group and she took on the task of hand painting the mission on each winning trophy. These ceramic tiles were kilns fired and then set in walnut. Some say that those trophies were the most special part of that first run. Did I neglect to mention that Olga is still making Charlie's good ideas a great success, she's his wife. In fact, from that first race Charlie and Olga started a cottage industry of race trophy manufacturing and soon they had more work than they could handle.

Charlie is also a gifted runner and after starting the Fiesta Mission Run he would jump in and run with the leaders. His PR was in 1979 at the Windcrest 10K in 39:18. He's run 17 marathons and last year at 75 years old he ran and won his age group at the Festival 10,000. We all want to thank the Merkelzs for their continued support of the San Antonio Road Runners and look forward to seeing them at this years 25<sup>th</sup> running of the Fiesta Mission Run.

The following are the race results as appeared in the SA Light of that first Fiesta Run in 1973.

### Garza Star of Fiesta Run

Juan Garza, Pan-American University star from Edinburg, won the 10,000meters (6.21 miles) in 32 minutes, 49 seconds, and came in first shoulder-to-shoulder with Tom Benson to share the mile victory in 5:05 at the first Mission Fiesta Runs sponsored Saturday by the Fiesta Association and the S.A. Road Runners.

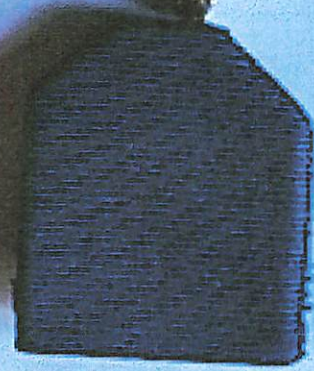

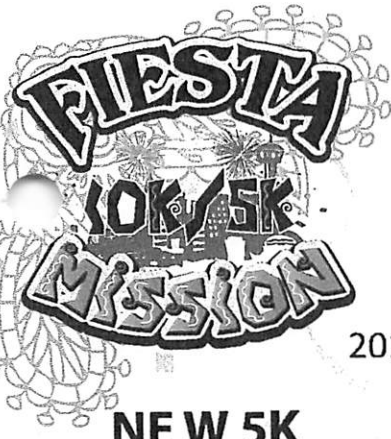

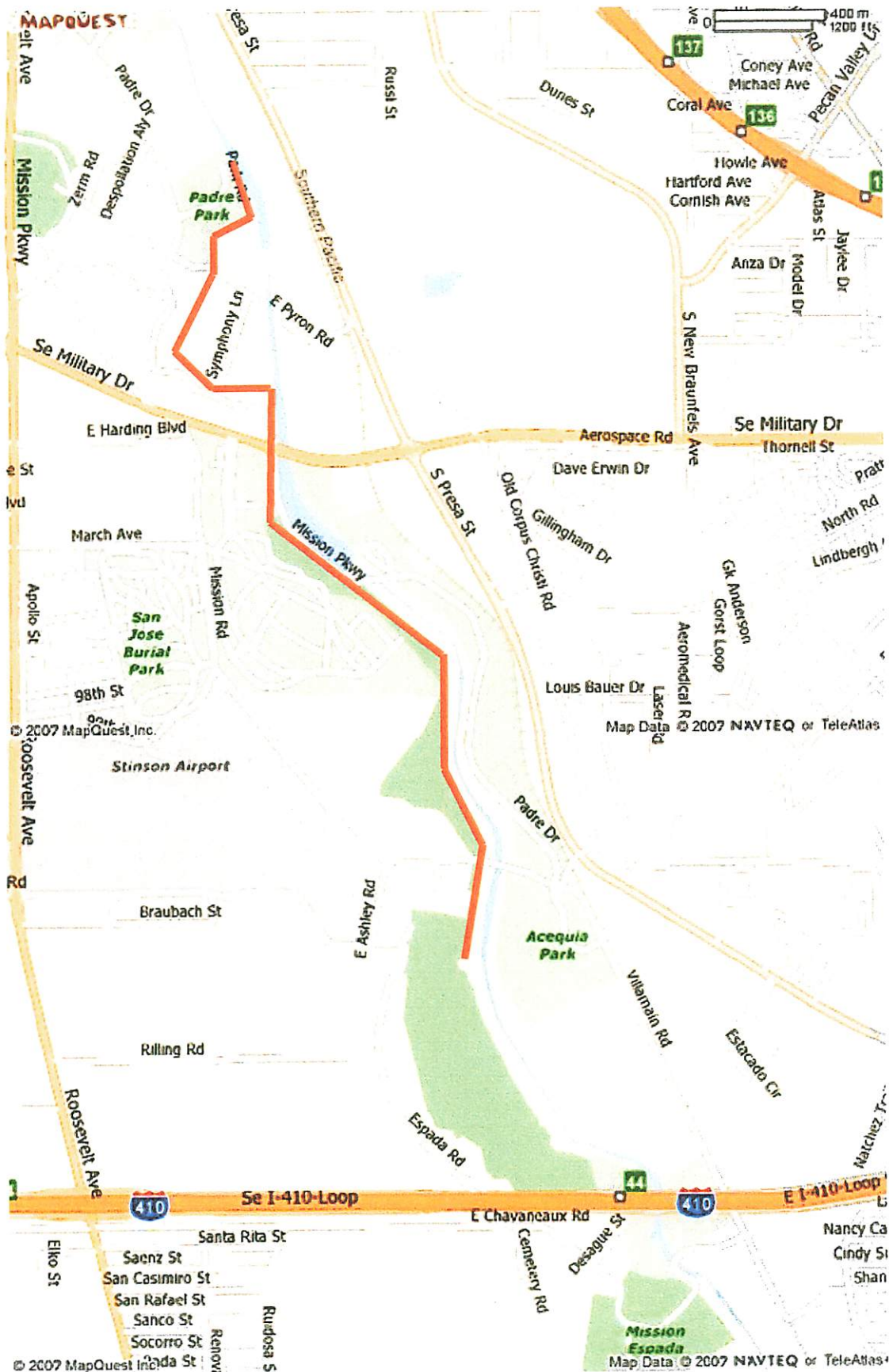
